AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to posting child day care provider qualifications on the office of children and family services' website

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- l Section 1. Section 390-a of the social services law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:
 - 6. LICENSED OR REGISTERED PROVIDERS MAY SUBMIT TO THE OFFICE OF CHIL-DREN AND FAMILY SERVICES ANY RELEVANT TRAINING COMPLETED BEYOND THAT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. SUCH TRAINING MAY INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, CREDENTIALS RECEIVED FROM A LOCAL, STATEWIDE OR NATIONAL ORGANIZATION, EDUCATIONAL CREDITS EARNED AND COURSES TAKEN IN THE FIELD OF EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT, EDUCATION OR SAFETY, AND ANY PARTICIPATION IN A QUALITY RATING AND IMPROVEMENT SYSTEM. THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES SHALL POST SUCH INFORMATION ON ITS WEBSITE.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
