AN ACT in relation to authorizing the village of Southampton, county of Suffolk to hire Gregg Kechlian to fill a full-time competitive position with the village of Southampton police department

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding section 58 of the civil service law or any
2 other law to the contrary, the village of Southampton, county of
3 Suffolk, is hereby authorized and directed upon the approval of the
4 village board of trustees and the police chief of the village of Southampton, to appoint Gregg Kechlian, who is currently employed as a full-time court officer and part-time police officer with the police department of the village of Southampton, to a full-time competitive position as a police officer with the police department of such village.

6 S 2. Gregg Kechlian shall be otherwise subject to the merit and
7 fitness provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time
8 police officers.

10 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
