AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to the New York Jockey Injury Compensation Fund, Inc.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 10 of section 221 of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, as amended by chapter 325 of the laws of 2004 and such section as renumbered by chapter 18 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 10. The fund shall be exempt from payment of all fees and all taxes 6 levied by this state or any of its subdivisions, except taxes levied on 7 property. THEFUND SHALL ALSO BE EXEMPT FROM PAYMENT OF ALL ASSESSMENTS UNDER SECTION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OF THE WORKERS' 8 COMPEN-9 SATION LAW AND NO INSURANCE CARRIER OR THE STATE INSURANCE FUND SHALL BE 10 REQUIRED TO COLLECT ANY SUCH ASSESSMENTS FROM THE FUND. ANY GROUP ESTAB-LISHED BY NEW YORK HORSEMEN UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION NINETY-ONE 11 12 OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW SHALL ALSO BE EXEMPT FROM PAYMENT 13 ASSESSMENTS UNDER SECTION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW AND THE STATE INSURANCE FUND SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED 14
- 15 COLLECT ANY SUCH ASSESSMENTS FROM ANY SUCH GROUP.
