AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to the peace officer status granted to officers or agents of a duly incorporated society for the prevention of cruelty to animals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law, as amended by chapter 734 of the laws of 1987, is amended to read as follows:
- 7. Officers or agents of a duly incorporated society for the prevention of cruelty to animals PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO AUTHORIZE ANY PERSON HIRED AS SUCH OFFICER OR AGENT AFTER NOVEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN TO CARRY, POSSESS, REPAIR OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM UNLESS THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR HAS BEEN ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
