AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the assault of a public health sanitarian

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivisions 3 and 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 259 of the laws of 2013, are amended to read as follows:

With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, PUBLIC HEALTH SANITARIAN, NEW YORK CITY PUBLIC HEALTH SANITARIAN, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, a firefighter, including a firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical technician administering first aid in the course of performance of duty as such firefighter, an emergency medical service paramedic or emergency medical service technician, or medical or related personnel in a hospital emergency department, a city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, from performing a lawful duty, by means including releasing or failing to control an animal under circumstances actor's intent that the animal obstruct the lawful activity of such peace officer, police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, PUBLIC HEALTH SANITARIAN, NEW YORK CITY PUBLIC HEALTH SANITARIAN, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, firefighter, paramedic, technician, city marshal, traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, he causes physical injury to such peace officer, police officer, prosecutor subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal defined in procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, PUBLIC HEALTH SANITARIAN, NEW YORK CITY PUBLIC HEALTH SANITARIAN, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, firefighter, paramedic, technician or medical or related personnel in a hospital emergency

S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
