AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing the retrain and employ unemployed persons program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6303-b 1 2 to read as follows:

3 S 6303-B. RETRAIN AND EMPLOY UNEMPLOYED PERSONS PROGRAM. 1. DEFI-NITIONS. AS USED IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING MEANINGS.

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6 (A) "GRANT PROGRAM" SHALL MEAN THE RETRAIN AND EMPLOY UNEMPLOYED 7 PERSONS PROGRAM OR THE RE-UP NEW YORK PROGRAM.

8 (B) "TRAINING PROGRAM OR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM" SHALL MEAN THE 9 COMMUNITY COLLEGE PROGRAMS CREATED OR IMPROVED PURSUANT TO THE GRANT 10 PROGRAM.

11 (C) "BOCES" SHALL MEAN BOARDS OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE FORTY OF THIS CHAPTER. 12

2. BY NO LATER THAN JULY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN THE STATE UNIVER-13 14 SITY BOARDS OF TRUSTEES AND THE CITY UNIVERSITY BOARDS OF TRUSTEES SHALL PROGRAM FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO DEVELOP TRAINING 15 ESTABLISH A GRANT 16 PROGRAMS OR IMPROVE EXISTING WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS FOR THE 17 PURPOSES OF TRAINING UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS FOR JOBS IN THE REGIONS SURROUNDING EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGES. 18

19 3. GRANTS SHALL BE AWARDED PURSUANT TO APPROPRIATION IN AN AMOUNT UΡ 20 FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS TO COMMUNITY COLLEGES THAT CAN DEMON-TO 21 STRATE THAT SUCH TRAINING PROGRAMS OR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS WILL PROVIDE THE REOUISITE TRAINING REOUIRED FOR JOB PLACEMENT IN BUSI-22 NESSES AND INDUSTRIES WITHIN THE REGION THAT LACK THE NECESSARY 23 WORK-FORCE OR THAT ARE SEEKING EMPLOYEES WITH NEW SKILLS IN AN AREA WHERE JOB 24 25 OPENINGS CURRENTLY EXIST OR WHERE JOB GROWTH IS ANTICIPATED IN THE NEAR 26 FUTURE.

27 4. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A GRANT, A COMMUNITY COLLEGE MUST ALSO DEMONSTRATE THAT SUCH COMMUNITY COLLEGE: (A) HAS PARTNERED WITH REGIONAL 28

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5. UPON SUCCESSFUL PLACEMENT OF TRAINING PROGRAM OR WORKFORCE DEVELOP7 MENT PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS, LOCAL BUSINESSES OR INDUSTRIES PARTNERING
8 WITH COMMUNITY COLLEGES PURSUANT TO THIS GRANT PROGRAM SHALL REIMBURSE
9 THE COMMUNITY COLLEGES FOR ONE-THIRD OF THE COST OF SUCH EMPLOYEE TRAIN10 ING.

11 6. COMMUNITY COLLEGES MAY SEEK TO PROVIDE ON-SITE TRAINING OR MAY SEEK 12 TO HAVE PARTICIPANTS TRAINED ON JOB SITES.

7. THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE, IN CONSULTATION WITH LOCAL BUSINESS OR 13 14 INDUSTRY, SHALL DETERMINE THE LENGTH OF SUCH TRAINING OR WORKFORCE 15 DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE COMPETENCY 16 FOR A PARTICULAR BUSINESS OR INDUSTRY NEED. SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF SUCH PROGRAMS SHALL BE SIGNIFIED BY THE RECEIPT OF A CERTIFICATE OF 17 COMPLETION, HOWEVER, TRAINING OR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS NEED NOT 18 19 LEAD TO DEGREES OR OFFICIAL CERTIFICATIONS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR 20 THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE.

8. BEGINNING IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN AND THEREAFTER, PURSUANT TO APPROPRIATION AND BASED ON THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS, COMMUNITY COLLEGES SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS IN ANY YEAR THAT MORE THAN FIFTY PERCENT OF ALL GRANT PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS TRAINED BECOME EMPLOYED.

SUNY AND CUNY BOARDS OF TRUSTEES SHALL ALSO CONSULT WITH REGIONAL 27 BOCES TO DEVELOP OR IMPROVE CAREER TRAINING PROGRAMS THAT WILL PARTNER 28 WITH COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND BUSINESS INDUSTRIES TO TRAIN MIDDLE SCHOOL 29 OR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS. IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A GRANT UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION, SUCH CAREER TRAINING PROGRAMS SHALL RESULT IN HIGH SCHOOL 30 GRADUATION AND ENROLLMENT IN A COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR PARTICIPATION IN A 31 32 RE-UP NEW YORK TRAINING OR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM. A PORTION OF THE FUNDING FOR THE BOCES, COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIP 33 MAY BE FUNDED BY THE PARTICIPATING BUSINESS OR INDUSTRY. 34 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 35
