AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to tuition assistance program awards

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 3 of section 667 of the educa-1 2 tion law, as amended by section 1 of part B of chapter 60 of the laws of 3 2000, item 1 of clause (A) of subparagraph (i) as amended by section 1 of part H of chapter 58 of the laws of 2011, the opening paragraph of 4 item 1 of clause (A) of subparagraph (i) as amended by section 2 of part 5 X of chapter 56 of the laws of 2014, subitem (a) of item 1 of clause (A) 6 7 subparagraph (i) as amended by section 2 of part U of chapter 56 of of 8 the laws of 2014, subitem (b) of item 1 of clause (A) of subparagraph (i) as amended by section 3 of part U of chapter 56 of the laws of 2014, 9 10 subitem (c) of item 1 of clause (A) of subparagraph (i) as amended by 11 section 1 of part U of chapter 56 of the laws of 2014, subitem (d) of item 1 of clause (A) of subparagraph (i) as added by section 1 of part E 12 chapter 58 of the laws of 2011, item 2 of clause (A) of subparagraph 13 of 14 (i) as amended by section 2 of part H of chapter 58 of the laws of 2011 15 subparagraph (iii) as amended by section 3 of part H of chapter 58 and 16 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

17 a. Amount. The president shall make awards to students enrolled in 18 degree-granting institutions or registered not-for-profit business 19 schools qualified for tax exemption under S 501(c)(3) of the internal 20 revenue code for federal income tax purposes in the following amounts:

(i) For each year of undergraduate study, assistance shall be provided as computed on the basis of the amount which is the lesser of the following:

(A) (1) In the case of students who have not been granted an exclusion of parental income, who have qualified as an orphan, foster child, or ward of the court for the purposes of federal student financial aid programs authorized by Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, or had a dependent for income tax purposes during the tax year

The award shall be the net amount of the base amount determined 39 (v) 40 pursuant to subparagraph (i) of this paragraph reduced pursuant to 41 subparagraph (ii) or (iii) of this paragraph but the award shall not be reduced for the two thousand--two thousand one and two thousand one--two 42 thousand two academic years below two hundred seventy-five dollars if 43 44 income is eighty thousand dollars or less and more than the amount of seventy thousand dollars, three hundred twenty-five dollars 45 if the amount of income is seventy thousand dollars or less and more than sixty thousand dollars and four hundred twenty-five dollars if the amount of 46 47 income is sixty thousand dollars or less. 48

(vi) For the two thousand two--two thousand three academic year and thereafter, the award shall be the net amount of the base amount determined pursuant to subparagraph (i) of this paragraph reduced pursuant to subparagraph (ii) or (iii) of this paragraph but the award shall not be reduced below five hundred dollars.

This act shall take effect April 1, 2015, provided that the addi-2 tion, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for 3 the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized and 4 directed to be made and completed by the president of the higher educa-5 tion services corporation on or before such effective date.
