- AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to providing information on where to seek help in regards to military sexual trauma

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 7.09 of the mental hygiene law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision (k) to read as follows:

3 (K) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DISSEMINATE INFORMATION TO VETERANS REGARD-ING WHICH UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEDICAL CENTERS, 4 OUTPATIENT CLINICS, COMMUNITY-BASED OUTPATIENT CLINICS, VET CENTERS OR 5 б OTHER UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS FACILITIES VETERANS 7 CAN SEEK TREATMENT, COUNSELLING AND RESOURCES FOR MILITARY SEXUAL TRAUMA 8 WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY OR DURING MILITARY TRAINING. SUCH EXPERIENCED 9 INFORMATION SHALL BE POSTED ON THE OFFICES WEBSITE WITH A LINK TO THE WEBSITE OF 10 THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS AND A LINK 11 TO THE WEBSITE OF THE STATE DIVISION OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS.

12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 13 have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately, the 14 commissioner of mental health shall promulgate any rules and regulations 15 necessary for the implementation of this act on or before its effective 16 date.
