AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to exempting compensation for active military service from inclusion in a resident's adjusted gross income

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph 8 of subsection (c) of section 612 of the tax law, as amended by chapter 528 of the laws of 1964, is amended to read as follows:

4 Compensation received for active service in the armed forces of the United States [on or after October first, nineteen hundred 6 one, and prior to September first, nineteen hundred sixty-two; provided, 7 that the amount of such compensation to be deducted shall not exceed one hundred dollars for each month of the taxable year, 8 9 quent to September, nineteen hundred sixty-one, during any part of which month the taxpayer was engaged in such service] TO THE EXTENT INCLUDIBLE 10 11 GROSS INCOME FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES AND NOT OTHERWISE EXCLUDED PURSUANT TO 12 PARAGRAPH EIGHT-C OF THIS SUBSECTION, TAXPAYER MAINTAINED A PERMANENT RESIDENCE IN NEW YORK STATE AND SERVED 13 14 IN THE ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES OUTSIDE 15 NEW YORK STATE FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST NINETY DAYS DURING THE TAXA-BLE YEAR. For the purposes of this paragraph, the words "active service the armed forces of the United States" shall mean active duty (other 17 18 than for training) in the army, navy (including the marine corps),
