AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to requiring insurance coverage for the influenza vaccine in certain circumstances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 1 Section 1. amended by adding a new paragraph 17-a to read as follows:
  - (17-A) EVERY POLICY DELIVERED OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY IN THIS MAJOR MEDICAL, MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE-TYPE PROVIDES COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR IMMUNIZING AGENTS TO PREVENT INFLUEN-ZA SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR INFLUENZA VACCINE AND ITS ADMINISTRATION WHEN SUCH VACCINE IS ADMINISTERED OUTSIDE A PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE AT ANY OFF-SITE LOCATION AUTHORIZED BY LAW. COVERAGE SHALL BEPROVIDED FOR IMMUNIZING AGENTS TO PREVENT INFLUENZA THAT ARE PRESCRIBED AND ADMINIS-TERED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THE EDUCATION LAW OR ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW OR RULE.
- S 2. Subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by 12 13 adding a new paragraph 8-a to read as follows:
- (8-A) EVERY GROUP OR BLANKET POLICY DELIVERED OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY 14 15 IN THIS STATE THAT PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPRE-HENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR IMMUNIZING AGENTS TO 16 PREVENT INFLUENZA SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR INFLUENZA VACCINE 17 AND ITS ADMINISTRATION WHEN SUCH VACCINE IS ADMINISTERED OUTSIDE A PHYSICIAN'S 18 19 OFFICE AT ANY OFF-SITE LOCATION AUTHORIZED BY LAW. COVERAGE SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR IMMUNIZING AGENTS TO PREVENT INFLUENZA THAT ARE PRESCRIBED
- 20 AND ADMINISTERED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH 21
- IN THE EDUCATION LAW OR ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW OR RULE. 22

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1 S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new 2 subsection (k-1) to read as follows:

(K-1) EVERY POLICY ISSUED BY A MEDICAL EXPENSE INDEMNITY CORPORATION, A HOSPITAL SERVICE CORPORATION OR A HEALTH SERVICE CORPORATION FOR DELIVERY IN THIS STATE THAT PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE FOR IMMUNIZING AGENTS TO PREVENT 7 SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR INFLUENZA VACCINE AND ITS ADMINISTRATION WHEN 8 SUCH VACCINE IS ADMINISTERED OUTSIDE A PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE AT ANY OFF-SITE LOCATION AUTHORIZED BY LAW. COVERAGE SHALL BE PROVIDED 9 10 IMMUNIZING AGENTS TO PREVENT INFLUENZA THAT ARE PRESCRIBED AND ADMINIS-TERED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH 11 EDUCATION LAW OR ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW OR RULE. 12

13 S 4. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
