- AN ACT in relation to authorizing the village of Lyons, county of Wayne to hire Brian M. Ritchie to fill a full-time competitive position with the village of Lyons police department

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 58 of the civil service law or any 1 2 other law to the contrary, the village of Lyons, county of Wayne, is hereby authorized and directed upon the approval of the village board of 3 trustees and the police chief of the village of Lyons, to appoint Brian 4 5 M. Ritchie, who is currently employed as a part-time police officer with the police department of the village of Lyons, to a full-time compet-6 7 itive position as a police officer with the police department of such 8 village.

9 S 2. Brian Ritchie shall be otherwise subject to the merit and fitness 10 provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time police offi-11 cers.

12 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
