AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring individuals and businesses who offer or solicit pet cremation or burial services for profit use a facility that is in compliance with New York state laws

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 750-b of the general business law, as added by 2 chapter 526 of the laws of 1992, is amended to read as follows:

S 750-b. License required. [On and after July thirty-first, nineteen hundred ninety-three, no person shall engage for a fee in the business of operating a pet cemetery or pet crematorium or hold himself or herself out as being able so to do unless he or she is licensed therefor pursuant to this article] THE STATE SHALL REQUIRE THAT ANY INDIVIDUAL, BUSINESS, OR ENTITY OFFERING OR SOLICITING PET CREMATION OR BURIAL SERVICES FOR PROFIT, IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK, USE A LICENSED CREMATORY OR CEMETERY LOCATED IN, LICENSED BY, AND SUBJECT TO REGULATION BY THE STATE OF NEW YORK. Nothing [herein] IN THIS SECTION shall prohibit a person licensed in accordance with the provisions of this article from employing individuals to assist in the operation of a pet cemetery or
