Introduced by Sens. MAZIARZ, LARKIN, MARCELLINO, RANZENHOFER, RITCHIE, YOUNG -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Energy and Telecommunications

AN ACT to amend the public service law and the tax law, in relation to creating the clean fuel and job creation tax credit of 2013 to incentivize power plants to repower existing facilities or construct new facilities which use cleaner burning fuels or add significant pollution control technologies

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 2 73 to read as follows:

3 S 73. COORDINATION WITH CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE TAX LAW. THE DEPART-4 MENT MAY REQUEST FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION AND FINANCE A LIST OF 5 ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITIES THAT HAVE BEEN GRANTED A CLEAN FUEL AND 6 CREATION TAX CREDIT AS SUCH CREDIT IS DESCRIBED IN SECTION JOB THIRTY-EIGHT OF THE TAX LAW. THE LIST SHALL INCLUDE THE LOCATION OF THE 7 8 FACILITY RECEIVING THE CREDIT, A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT TO WHICH THE 9 CREDIT RELATES, THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT, AND THE TAX YEAR FOR WHICH THE 10 CREDIT WAS GRANTED.

11 S 2. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 38 to read as 12 follows:

13 S 38. CLEAN FUEL AND JOB CREATION TAX CREDIT. (A) ALLOWANCE OF CREDIT. A TAXPAYER SUBJECT TO TAX UNDER ARTICLE NINE, NINE-A OR TWENTY-TWO OF 14 15 THIS CHAPTER, WHICH IS AN ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY, SHALL BE ALLOWED CREDIT AGAINST SUCH TAX, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS REFERENCED IN 16 Α SUBDIVISION (C) OF THIS SECTION. 17 THE CREDIT SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR CERTAIN INVESTMENTS MADE BY ANY MAJOR ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY IN 18 19 THE STATE SUCH AS REPOWERING PROJECTS, QUALIFIED ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE 20 INVESTMENTS, AND QUALIFIED NEW CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AS DESCRIBED IN 21 THIS SECTION. THE CREDIT SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

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(1) TWELVE AND ONE-HALF PERCENT OF 1 THEFIRST ONE HUNDRED MILLION 2 DOLLARS IN INVESTMENT; 3 (2) FIFTEEN PERCENT OF THE NEXT ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS IN INVEST-4 MENT OR PORTION THEREOF; AND 5 TWENTY PERCENT OF THE TOTAL INVESTMENT OVER AND ABOVE TWO HUNDRED (3) 6 MILLION DOLLARS. 7 (B) DEFINITIONS. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING MEANINGS: 8 9 "REPOWERING PROJECT" SHALL MEAN IMPROVEMENTS TO AN EXISTING MAJOR (1)10 ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY THAT WILL ALLOW THE FACILITY, OR A NEW UNIT OR UNITS AT THE FACILITY, OR THE COMBINATION OF THE NEW UNIT 11 OR UNITS THE FACILITY TO INCREASE ITS OVERALL EFFICIENCY, AS DEMONSTRATED BY 12 AND A REDUCTION IN HEAT RATE, AND TO MEET THE FOLLOWING RELEVANT 13 ENVIRON-14 MENTAL REOUIREMENTS: 15 (I) A DECREASE IN THE RATE OF EMISSION EXPRESSED AS A POUNDS PER MEGA-16 WATT-HOUR REDUCTION OF EACH OF THE RELEVANT SITING AIR CONTAMINANTS; AND 17 (II) COOLING WATER WITHDRAWAL CONSISTENT WITH A RATE EQUAL TO OR LESS 18 THAN CLOSED-CYCLE COOLING. 19 (2) "ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS", EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED IΝ 20 PARAGRAPH ONE OF THIS SUBDIVISION, SHALL MEAN: 21 AN INCREASE IN OVERALL EFFICIENCY AS DEMONSTRATED BY A REDUCTION (I) 22 IN HEAT RATE; 23 (II) A DECREASE IN THE RATE OF EMISSION EXPRESSED AS A POUNDS PER 24 MEGAWATT-HOUR REDUCTION OF EACH OF THE RELEVANT SITING AIR CONTAMINANTS; 25 AND 26 (III) COOLING WATER WITHDRAWAL CONSISTENT WITH A RATE EQUAL TO OR LESS 27 THAN CLOSED-CYCLE COOLING. 28 "QUALIFIED ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT" (3) SHALL MEAN ANY 29 INVESTMENT NEEDED TO DELIVER A NEW FUEL SOURCE TO AN EXISTING ELECTRIC 30 GENERATING FACILITY, REPLACE OR RETROFIT A BURNER OR TURBINE, UTILIZE ON-SITE RENEWABLE ENERGY GENERATION, OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANTIAL INVESTMENT 31 32 THAT WILL HAVE A DIRECT IMPACT ON THE FACILITY'S ABILITY TO MEET RELE-33 VANT ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS. 34 (4) "OUALIFIED NEW CONSTRUCTION PROJECT" SHALL MEAN CONSTRUCTING A NEW 35 MAJOR ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY IN THE SAME LOCATION AS AN EXISTING FACILITY OR ON PROPERTY DIRECTLY ADJACENT OR CONTIGUOUS TO SAID PROPER-36 37 TY, WHERE THE NEW FACILITY BY ITSELF OR IN COMBINATION WITH THE EXISTING 38 FACILITY WILL ALLOW THE SITE AS A WHOLE TO MEET RELEVANT ENVIRONMENTAL 39 **REQUIREMENTS.** 40 (5) "MAJOR ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY" SHALL MEAN A MAJOR ELECTRIC 41 GENERATING FACILITY AS DEFINED IN SECTION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY OF THE 42 PUBLIC SERVICE LAW. 43 (C) A MAJOR ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY WHICH UNDERTAKES A REPOWERING 44 PROJECT, A QUALIFIED ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT, A QUALIFIED NEW 45 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, OR OTHER INVESTMENT IN POLLUTION CONTROL EQUIPMENT OR ADDITIONAL ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE WITH THE GOAL OF MEETING RELEVANT 46 47 ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE ALLOWED TO CLAIM A CREDIT UNDER THIS 48 SECTION.

49 S 3. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 187-s to read as 50 follows:

51 S 187-S. CLEAN FUEL AND JOB CREATION TAX CREDIT. (A) ALLOWANCE OF 52 CREDIT. A TAXPAYER SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT, TO BE COMPUTED AS PROVIDED 53 IN SECTION THIRTY-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER, AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY 54 SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE AND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR OF THIS 55 ARTICLE.

(B) APPLICATION OF CREDIT. IN NO EVENT SHALL THE CREDIT UNDER THIS 1 SECTION BE ALLOWED IN AN AMOUNT WHICH WILL REDUCE THE TAX PAYABLE TO 2 3 LESS THAN THE APPLICABLE MINIMUM TAX FIXED BY SECTION ONE HUNDRED EIGHT-4 Y-THREE OR ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR OF THIS ARTICLE. IF, HOWEVER, THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT ALLOWABLE UNDER THIS SECTION FOR ANY TAXABLE YEAR REDUCES THE TAX TO SUCH AMOUNT, ANY AMOUNT OF CREDIT NOT DEDUCTIBLE IN 5 6 7 SUCH TAXABLE YEAR MAY BE CARRIED OVER TO THE FOLLOWING YEAR OR YEARS AND 8 MAY BE DEDUCTED FROM THE TAXPAYER'S TAX FOR SUCH YEAR OR YEARS.

9 S 4. Section 210 of the tax law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 46 to read as follows:

46. CLEAN FUEL AND JOB CREATION TAX CREDIT. (A) ALLOWANCE OF CREDIT. A TAXPAYER SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT, TO BE COMPUTED AS PROVIDED IN SECTION THIRTY-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER, AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS ARTICLE.

15 (B) APPLICATION OF CREDIT. THE CREDIT ALLOWED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION 16 FOR ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY NOT REDUCE THE TAX DUE FOR SUCH YEAR TO LESS THAN THE AMOUNT PRESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (D) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS 17 SECTION. HOWEVER, IF THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT ALLOWED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION 18 19 FOR ANY TAXABLE YEAR REDUCES THE TAX TO SUCH AMOUNT, ANY AMOUNT OF CRED-IT THUS NOT DEDUCTIBLE IN SUCH TAXABLE YEAR WILL BE TREATED AS AN OVER-20 21 PAYMENT OF TAX TO BE CREDITED OR REFUNDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION ONE THOUSAND EIGHTY-SIX OF THIS CHAPTER. PROVIDED, 22 HOWEVER, THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (C) OF SECTION ONE THOUSAND EIGHT-23 Y-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER NOTWITHSTANDING, NO INTEREST WILL BE PAID THERE-24 25 ON.

26 S 5. Section 606 of the tax law is amended by adding a new subsection 27 (vv) to read as follows:

28 (VV) CLEAN FUEL AND JOB CREATION TAX CREDIT. (1) ALLOWANCE OF CREDIT.
29 A TAXPAYER SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT, TO BE COMPUTED AS PROVIDED IN
30 SECTION THIRTY-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER, AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS
31 ARTICLE.

(2) APPLICATION OF CREDIT. IF THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT ALLOWED UNDER
THIS SUBSECTION FOR ANY TAXABLE YEAR EXCEEDS THE TAXPAYER'S TAX FOR SUCH
YEAR, THE EXCESS WILL BE TREATED AS AN OVERPAYMENT OF TAX TO BE CREDITED
OR REFUNDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION SIX HUNDRED
EIGHTY-SIX OF THIS ARTICLE, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT NO INTEREST WILL BE
PAID THEREON.

38 S 6. Subparagraph (B) of paragraph 1 of subsection (i) of section 606 39 of the tax law is amended by adding a new clause (xxxv) to read as 40 follows:
