AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requirements of proof for certain licenses; and to repeal certain provisions of such law in relation thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of 2 section 490 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 235 of 3 the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

4 The commissioner shall upon submission of an appropriate applica-(i) 5 tion, upon payment of the prescribed fee, and upon being satisfied that 6 the person described is the applicant and that such applicant meets the 7 requirements set forth in subdivision two of this section, issue to such 8 applicant a nontransferable identification card. In addition. the 9 commissioner also shall require that an applicant for an identification card or renewal thereof provide his or her social security number, OR 10 PROVIDE PROOF THAT HEOR SHE IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY 11 NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BY AN 12 APPLICANT 13 ТΟ THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECU-14 15 RITY NUMBER.

16 S 2. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section 490 17 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 487 of the laws of 18 2012, is amended to read as follows:

(i) The commissioner shall upon submission of an appropriate application, upon payment of the prescribed fee, and upon being satisfied that the person described is the applicant and that such applicant meets the requirements set forth in subdivision two of this section, issue to such applicant a nontransferable identification card. In addition, the commissioner also shall require that an applicant for an identification

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card or renewal thereof provide his or her social security number, OR 1 PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL 2 SECURITY 3 SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT NUMBER. 4 TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF 5 DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECU-6 RITY NUMBER. The commissioner shall provide space so that an applicant 7 may request a notation upon such identification card that he or she is a 8 veteran of the United States armed forces.

9 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 10 amended by section 1 of part D of chapter 58 of the laws of 2012, is 11 amended to read as follows:

12 Application for license. Application for a driver's license shall 1. be made to the commissioner. The fee prescribed by law may be submitted 13 14 with such application. The applicant shall furnish such proof of identi-15 ty, age, and fitness as may be required by the commissioner. The commis-16 sioner may also provide that the application procedure shall include the 17 taking of a photo image or images of the applicant in accordance with 18 rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner. In addition, the 19 commissioner [also] shall require that the applicant provide his or her 20 social security number [and], OR PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS NOT 21 ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCU-22 MENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOME-SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS 23 LAND 24 ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL 25 ALSO provide space on the application so that the applicant may register 26 in the New York state organ and tissue donor registry under section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law. In addition, an appli-27 28 cant for a commercial driver's license who will operate a commercial 29 motor vehicle in interstate commerce shall certify that such applicant meets the requirements to operate a commercial motor vehicle, as set 30 forth in public law 99-570, title XII, and title 49 of the code of 31 32 federal regulations, and all regulations promulgated by the United 33 States secretary of transportation under the hazardous materials trans-34 portation act. In addition, an applicant for a commercial driver's license shall submit a medical certificate at such intervals as required 35 36 the federal motor carrier safety improvement act of 1999 and Part by 37 383.71(h) of title 49 of the code of federal regulations relating to medical certification and in a manner prescribed by the commissioner. 38 For purposes of this section and sections five hundred three, five 39 40 hundred ten-a, and five hundred ten-aa of this title, the terms "medical certificate" and "medical certification" shall mean a form substantially 41 in compliance with the form set forth in Part 391.43(h) of title 49 of 42 43 the code of federal regulations. Upon a determination that the holder of 44 a commercial driver's license has made any false statement, with respect 45 to the application for such license, the commissioner shall revoke such 46 license.

47 S 4. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 48 separately amended by chapters 465 and 487 of the laws of 2012, is 49 REPEALED and a new subdivision 1 is added to read as follows:

50 APPLICATION FOR LICENSE. APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE SHALL 1. BE MADE TO THE COMMISSIONER. THE FEE PRESCRIBED BY LAW MAY BE 51 SUBMITTED 52 SUCH APPLICATION. THE APPLICANT SHALL FURNISH SUCH PROOF OF IDEN-WITH TITY, AGE, AND FITNESS AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY 53 THE COMMISSIONER. THE 54 COMMISSIONER MAY ALSO PROVIDE THAT THE APPLICATION PROCEDURE SHALL 55 INCLUDE THE TAKING OF A PHOTO IMAGE OR IMAGES OF THE APPLICANT IN 56 ACCORDANCE WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER.

IN ADDITION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE APPLICANT PROVIDE 1 2 OR HER SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, OR PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS HIS 3 NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY 4 DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF 5 HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT 6 ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL IS 7 ALSO PROVIDE SPACE ON THE APPLICATION SO THAT THE APPLICANT MAY REGISTER 8 IN THE NEW YORK STATE ORGAN AND TISSUE DONOR REGISTRY UNDER SECTION 9 FORTY-THREE HUNDRED TEN OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW WITH THE FOLLOWING 10 STATED ON THE APPLICATION IN CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS TYPE:

11 "YOU MUST FILL OUT THE FOLLOWING SECTION: WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE ADDED 12 TO THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY? CHECK BOX FOR 'YES' OR 'SKIP THIS QUES-13 TION'."

14 THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL NOT MAINTAIN 15 RECORDS OF ANY PERSON WHO CHECKS "SKIP THIS QUESTION". FAILURE TO CHECK 16 A BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR THE VALIDITY OF AN APPLICATION, AND FAILURE ТО 17 "YES" OR CHECKING "SKIP THIS QUESTION" SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO CHECK IMPLY A WISH NOT TO DONATE. IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT UNDER 18 EIGHTEEN 19 YEARS OF AGE, CHECKING "YES" SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE CONSENT TO MAKE AN 20 ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGISTRATION IN THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY. WHERE AN 21 APPLICANT HAS PREVIOUSLY CONSENTED TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGIS-TERED IN THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY, CHECKING "SKIP THIS QUESTION" OR 22 FAILING TO CHECK A BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR THAT CONSENT OR REGISTRATION. IN 23 ADDITION, THE COMMISSIONER ALSO SHALL REQUIRE THAT 24 SPACE SHALL BE 25 PROVIDED ON THE APPLICATION SO THAT THE APPLICANT MAY REQUEST A NOTATION 26 UPON SUCH LICENSE THAT HE OR SHE IS A VETERAN OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED 27 FORCES. IN ADDITION, AN APPLICANT FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE WHO COMMERCE SHALL 28 WILL OPERATE A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IN INTERSTATE CERTIFY THAT SUCH APPLICANT MEETS THE REOUIREMENTS TO OPERATE A COMMER-29 CIAL MOTOR VEHICLE, AS SET FORTH IN PUBLIC LAW 99-570, TITLE XII, AND 30 TITLE 49 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS, AND ALL REGULATIONS PROMUL-31 GATED BY THE UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION UNDER THE HAZARD-32 33 OUS MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION ACT. IN ADDITION, AN APPLICANT FOR A 34 COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AT SUCH 35 INTERVALS AS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY IMPROVEMENT OF 1999 AND PART 383.71(H) OF TITLE 49 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGU-36 ACT 37 LATIONS RELATING TO MEDICAL CERTIFICATION AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY 38 THE COMMISSIONER. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION AND SECTIONS FIVE HUNDRED 39 THREE, FIVE HUNDRED TEN-A, AND FIVE HUNDRED TEN-AA OF THIS TITLE, THE 40 TERMS "MEDICAL CERTIFICATE" AND "MEDICAL CERTIFICATION" SHALL MEAN A FORM SUBSTANTIALLY IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE FORM SET 41 FORTH IN PART 391.43(H) OF TITLE 49 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS. UPON A DETER-42 43 MINATION THAT THE HOLDER OF A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE HAS MADE ANY FALSE STATEMENT, WITH RESPECT TO THE APPLICATION FOR SUCH LICENSE, 44 THE 45 COMMISSIONER SHALL REVOKE SUCH LICENSE.

S 5. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 46 47 added by section four of this act, is amended to read as follows: 48 1. Application for license. Application for a driver's license shall be made to the commissioner. The fee prescribed by law may be submitted 49 50 with such application. The applicant shall furnish such proof of iden-51 tity, age, and fitness as may be required by the commissioner. The commissioner may also provide that the application procedure shall include the taking of a photo image or images of the applicant in 52 53 54 accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner. 55 In addition, the commissioner shall require that the applicant provide 56 his or her social security number, or provide proof that he or she is

not eligible for a social security number. Such proof may include any 1 2 documents submitted by an applicant to the United States department of 3 homeland security for the purpose of determining whether such applicant 4 is eligible to receive a social security number. The commissioner shall also provide space on the application so that the applicant may register 5 6 in the New York state organ and tissue donor registry under section 7 forty-three hundred ten of the public health law [with the following 8 stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type:

9 "You must fill out the following section: Would you like to be added 10 to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this ques-11 tion'."

The commissioner of the department of health shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check 12 13 14 a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to 15 check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to 16 imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under eighteen age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an 17 years of 18 anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an 19 applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or 20 failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration]. 21 22 addition, the commissioner also shall require that space shall be In 23 provided on the application so that the applicant may request a notation upon such license that he or she is a veteran of the United States armed 24 25 In addition, an applicant for a commercial driver's license who forces. will operate a commercial motor vehicle in interstate 26 commerce shall certify that such applicant meets the requirements to operate a commer-27 28 cial motor vehicle, as set forth in public law 99-570, title XII, and 29 title 49 of the code of federal regulations, and all regulations promulgated by the United States secretary of transportation under the hazard-30 ous materials transportation act. In addition, an applicant for a 31 32 commercial driver's license shall submit a medical certificate at such 33 intervals as required by the federal motor carrier safety improvement act of 1999 and Part 383.71(h) of title 49 of the code of federal regu-34 35 lations relating to medical certification and in a manner prescribed by the commissioner. For purposes of this section and sections five hundred 36 37 three, five hundred ten-a, and five hundred ten-aa of this title, the 38 terms "medical certificate" and "medical certification" shall mean a 39 form substantially in compliance with the form set forth in Part 40 391.43(h) of title 49 of the code of federal regulations. Upon a determination that the holder of a commercial driver's license has made any 41 false statement, with respect to the application for such license, the 42 commissioner shall revoke such license. 43

S 6. This act shall take effect immediately; provided however that section two of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as section 1 of chapter 487 of the laws of 2012 takes effect; provided further that section four of this act shall take effect October 3, 2013; and provided further that section five of this act shall take effect October 3, 2016.
