AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to mandatory continuing education for mental health practitioners and clarifies authorization to practice

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 8412
2 to read as follows:

3 S 8412. MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION. 1. REQUIREMENT OF CONTINUING 4 EDUCATION.

5 (A) EACH LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERA-6 PIST, PSYCHOANALYST, AND CREATIVE ARTS THERAPIST REQUIRED UNDER THIS 7 REGISTER TRIENNIALLY WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO PRACTICE IN THE ARTICLE то 8 STATE SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE MANDATORY CONTINUING 9 EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPHS (B) AND (C) OF 10 THIS SUBDIVISION. HEALTH COUNSELORS, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS, 11 LICENSED MENTAL 12 PSYCHOANALYSTS AND CREATIVE ARTS THERAPISTS WHO DO NOT SATISFY THE 13 MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SHALL NOT PRACTICE UNTIL THEY HAVE MET SUCH REQUIREMENTS, AND THEY HAVE BEEN ISSUED A REGISTRA-14 15 CERTIFICATE, EXCEPT THAT A LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, TION 16 MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST, PSYCHOANALYST, AND CREATIVE ARTS THERA-17 MAY PRACTICE WITHOUT HAVING MET SUCH REQUIREMENTS IF HE OR SHE IS PIST 18 ISSUED A CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE PURSUANT ТО SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION. 19

(B) 20 EACH LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERA-PIST, PSYCHOANALYST, AND CREATIVE ARTS THERAPIST SHALL BE 21 EXEMPT FROM 22 MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT FOR THE TRIENNIAL REGIS-THE 23 TRATION PERIOD DURING WHICH THEY ARE FIRST LICENSED. IN ACCORDANCE WITH 24 SECTION, ADJUSTMENT TO THE MANDATORY CONTINUING THE INTENT OF THIS

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1 EDUCATION REQUIREMENT MAY BE GRANTED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR REASONS OF 2 HEALTH CERTIFIED BY AN APPROPRIATE HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL, FOR 3 EXTENDED ACTIVE DUTY WITH THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, OR FOR 4 OTHER GOOD CAUSE ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT WHICH MAY PREVENT COMPLI-5 ANCE.

6 (C) A LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST, 7 PSYCHOANALYST, AND CREATIVE ARTS THERAPIST NOT ENGAGED IN PRACTICE, AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE MANDATORY CONTIN-8 UING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT UPON THE FILING OF A STATEMENT WITH THE 9 10 DEPARTMENT DECLARING SUCH STATUS. ANY LICENSEE WHO RETURNS TO THE PRAC-TICE OF MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY, PSYCHO-11 12 ANALYSIS, OR CREATIVE ARTS THERAPY DURING THE TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD SHALL NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO REENTERING THE PROFESSION 13 14 AND SHALL MEET SUCH MANDATORY EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS AS SHALL BE 15 PRESCRIBED BY REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER.

16 2. DURING EACH TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD AN APPLICANT FOR REGIS-17 TRATION AS A LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THER-APIST, PSYCHOANALYST, AND CREATIVE ARTS THERAPIST SHALL COMPLETE A MINI-18 MUM OF THIRTY-SIX HOURS OF ACCEPTABLE FORMAL CONTINUING EDUCATION AS SPECIFIED IN SUBDIVISION FOUR OF THIS SECTION, A MAXIMUM OF TWELVE HOURS 19 20 21 OF WHICH MAY BE SELF-INSTRUCTIONAL COURSE WORK ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPART-MENT. ANY LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERA-22 PIST, PSYCHOANALYST, AND CREATIVE ARTS THERAPIST WHOSE FIRST REGISTRA-23 TION DATE FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION OCCURS LESS THAN 24 25 THREE YEARS FROM SUCH EFFECTIVE DATE, BUT ON OR AFTER JUNE THIRTIETH, 26 TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN, SHALL COMPLETE CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS ON A PRORATED BASIS AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF HOUR PER MONTH FOR THE 27 PERIOD BEGINNING JUNE THIRTIETH, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN UP TO THE FIRST REGIS-28 29 TRATION DATE THEREAFTER. A LICENSEE WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SHALL NOT BE ISSUED A TRIENNIAL REGIS-30 TRATION CERTIFICATE BY THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL NOT PRACTICE UNLESS AND 31 32 UNTIL A CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED AS PROVIDED FOR 33 SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION. CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS TAKEN IN34 DURING ONE TRIENNIUM MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO A SUBSEQUENT TRIENNIUM. 35 3. THE DEPARTMENT, IN ITS DISCRETION, MAY ISSUE A CONDITIONAL REGIS-TRATION TO A LICENSEE WHO FAILS TO MEET THE CONTINUING EDUCATION 36 37 REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION BUT WHO

38 AGREES TO MAKE UP ANY DEFICIENCIES AND COMPLETE ANY ADDITIONAL EDUCATION 39 WHICH THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE. THE FEE FOR SUCH A CONDITIONAL REGIS-40 TRATION SHALL BE THE SAME AS, AND IN ADDITION TO, THE FEE FOR THE TRIEN-NIAL REGISTRATION. THE DURATION OF SUCH CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION SHALL 41 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT BUT SHALL NOT EXCEED ONE YEAR. ANY 42 BE 43 LICENSEE WHO IS NOTIFIED OF THE DENIAL OF REGISTRATION FOR FAILURE ТО SUBMIT EVIDENCE, SATISFACTORY TO THE DEPARTMENT, OF REQUIRED CONTINUING 44 45 EDUCATION AND WHO PRACTICES WITHOUT SUCH REGISTRATION MAY BE SUBJECT ΤO DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS PURSUANT TO SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED TEN OF 46 47 THIS TITLE.

48 4. AS USED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION, "ACCEPTABLE FORMAL 49 CONTINUING EDUCATION" SHALL MEAN FORMAL COURSES OF LEARNING WHICH 50 TO PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE IN MENTAL HEALTH CONTRIBUTE COUNSELING, 51 MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY, PSYCHOANALYSIS, OR CREATIVE ARTS THERAPY AND WHICH MEET THE STANDARDS PRESCRIBED BY REGULATIONS OF THE COMMIS-52 SIONER. SUCH FORMAL COURSES OF LEARNING SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMIT-53 54 ED TO, COLLEGIATE LEVEL CREDIT AND NON-CREDIT COURSES, PROFESSIONAL 55 DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS AND TECHNICAL SESSIONS OFFERED BY NATIONAL, STATE 56 AND LOCAL PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS ACCEPTABLE

TO THE DEPARTMENT, AND ANY OTHER ORGANIZED EDUCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL 1 2 TO THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT MAY, IN ITS PROGRAMS ACCEPTABLE 3 DISCRETION AND AS NEEDED TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF THE 4 PUBLIC, REOUIRE THE COMPLETION OF CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES IN 5 SPECIFIC SUBJECTS TO FULFILL THIS MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION 6 COURSES MUST BE TAKEN FROM A SPONSOR APPROVED BY THE REQUIREMENT. 7 DEPARTMENT, PURSUANT TO THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER.

8 5. LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELORS, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS, 9 PSYCHOANALYSTS, AND CREATIVE ARTS THERAPISTS SHALL MAINTAIN ADEQUATE 10 DOCUMENTATION OF COMPLETION OF ACCEPTABLE FORMAL CONTINUING EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE SUCH DOCUMENTATION AT THE REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT. 11 AND FAILURE TO PROVIDE SUCH DOCUMENTATION UPON THE REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT 12 SHALL BE AN ACT OF MISCONDUCT SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS PURSU-13 14 ANT TO SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED TEN OF THIS TITLE.

6. THE MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION FEE SHALL BE FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS,
SHALL BE PAYABLE ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF EACH TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD, AND SHALL BE PAID IN ADDITION TO THE TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION
FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION SIXTY-SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR OF THIS CHAPTER.
S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 8402 of the education law, as added by

20 chapter 676 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows: 21 1. Definition of the practice of mental health counseling. The prac-22 tice of the profession of mental health counseling is defined as:

(a) the evaluation, assessment, DIAGNOSIS, amelioration, treatment, modification, or adjustment to a disability, problem, or disorder of behavior, character, development, emotion, personality or relationships by the use of verbal or behavioral methods with individuals, couples, families or groups in private practice, group, or organized settings; [and]

(b) the use of assessment instruments and mental health counseling and psychotherapy to identify, evaluate, DIAGNOSE and treat dysfunctions and disorders for purposes of providing appropriate mental health counseling services; AND

39 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 8403 of the education law, as added by 40 chapter 676 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

1. Definition of the practice of marriage and family therapy. 41 The practice of the profession of marriage and family therapy is defined as: 42 43 the assessment, DIAGNOSIS and treatment of nervous and mental (a) 44 disorders, whether affective, cognitive or behavioral, which results in 45 dysfunctional interpersonal family relationships including, but not limited to familial relationships, marital/couple relationships, 46 47 parent-child relationships, pre-marital and other personal relation-48 ships;

(b) the use of mental health counseling, psychotherapy and therapeutic techniques to evaluate and treat marital, relational, and family systems, and individuals in relationship to these systems;

52 (c) the use of mental health counseling and psychotherapeutic tech-53 niques to treat mental, emotional and behavioral disorders and ailments 54 within the context of marital, relational and family systems to prevent 55 and ameliorate dysfunction; [and] 1 (d) the use of assessment instruments and mental health counseling and 2 psychotherapy to identify [and], evaluate, DIAGNOSE AND TREAT dysfunc-3 tions and disorders for purposes of providing appropriate marriage and 4 family therapy services; AND

5 DIAGNOSIS IN THE CONTEXT OF LICENSED MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY (E) 6 PRACTICE IS PROCESS OF DISTINGUISHING BETWEEN SIMILAR MENTAL, THE7 EMOTIONAL, BEHAVIORAL, DEVELOPMENTAL, AND ADDICTIVE DISORDERS, IMPAIR-8 MENTS AND DISABILITIES WITHIN A PSYCHOSOCIAL FRAMEWORK ON THE BASIS OF 9 THEIR SIMILAR AND UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS CONSISTENT WITH ACCEPTED CLAS-10 SIFICATION SYSTEMS.

11 S 4. Subdivision 1 of section 8404 of the education law, as added by 12 chapter 676 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

13 1. Definition of the practice of creative arts therapy. The practice 14 of the profession of creative arts therapy is defined as:

(a) the assessment, evaluation, DIAGNOSIS and the therapeutic intervention and treatment, which may be either primary, parallel or adjunctive, of mental, emotional, developmental and behavioral disorders through the use of the arts as approved by the department; [and]

19 (b) the use of assessment instruments and mental health counseling and 20 psychotherapy to identify, evaluate, DIAGNOSE and treat dysfunctions and 21 disorders for purposes of providing appropriate creative arts therapy 22 services; AND

(C) DIAGNOSIS IN THE CONTEXT OF LICENSED CREATIVE ARTS THERAPY PRACTICE IS THE PROCESS OF DISTINGUISHING BETWEEN SIMILAR MENTAL, EMOTIONAL,
BEHAVIORAL, DEVELOPMENTAL, AND ADDICTIVE DISORDERS, IMPAIRMENTS AND
DISABILITIES WITHIN A PSYCHOSOCIAL FRAMEWORK ON THE BASIS OF THEIR SIMILAR AND UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS CONSISTENT WITH ACCEPTED CLASSIFICATION
SYSTEMS.

29 S 5. Subdivision 1 of section 8405 of the education law, as added by 30 chapter 676 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

1. Definition of the practice of psychoanalysis. The practice of the profession of psychoanalysis is defined as:

33 (a) the observation, description, evaluation, [and] interpretation, DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT of dynamic unconscious mental processes that 34 contribute to the formation of personality and behavior in order to 35 identify and resolve unconscious psychic problems which affect interper-36 37 sonal relationships and emotional development, to facilitate changes in 38 personality and behavior through the use of verbal and nonverbal cogni-39 tive and emotional communication, and to develop adaptive functioning; 40 [and]

(b) the use of assessment instruments and mental health counseling and psychotherapy to identify, evaluate, DIAGNOSE and treat dysfunctions and disorders for purposes of providing appropriate psychoanalytic services; AND

45 (C) DIAGNOSIS IN THE CONTEXT OF LICENSED PSYCHOANALYSIS PRACTICE IS
46 THE PROCESS OF DISTINGUISHING BETWEEN SIMILAR MENTAL, EMOTIONAL, BEHAV47 IORAL, DEVELOPMENTAL, AND ADDICTIVE DISORDERS, IMPAIRMENTS AND DISABILI48 TIES WITHIN A PSYCHOSOCIAL FRAMEWORK ON THE BASIS OF THEIR SIMILAR AND

50 S 6. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, 51 section one of this act shall take effect June 30, 2014. Effective imme-52 diately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation 53 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are 54 authorized and directed to be made and completed by the state education 55 department.
