- AN ACT to amend the real property actions and proceedings law, in relation to establishing a one year moratorium on actions to foreclose a mortgage

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The real property actions and proceedings law is amended by 2 adding a new section 1392 to read as follows:

3 S 1392. MORATORIUM ON ACTIONS TO FORECLOSE A MORTGAGE. 1. BEGINNING ON 4 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION AND ENDING ONE YEAR AFTER SUCH DATE, 5 NO ACTION TO FORECLOSE A MORTGAGE ON REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THIS STATE 6 SHALL BE BROUGHT PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE IN ANY COURT IN THIS STATE.

7 2. ANY MORTGAGOR IN THIS STATE WHO OWNS PROPERTY IN THIS STATE THAT 8 SUBJECT TO AN ACTION TO FORECLOSE SUCH MORTGAGE WOULD OTHERWISE BE PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL ENTER INTO GOOD FAITH NEGOTIATIONS WITH 9 10 THE MORTGAGEE OF SUCH MORTGAGE TO NEGOTIATE TERMS FOR REPAYMENT OF THE LOAN SECURED BY SUCH MORTGAGE. UPON AGREEMENT OF SUCH TERMS, SUCH MORT-11 12 GAGOR SHALL MAKE PAYMENTS TO SUCH MORTGAGEE ACCORDING TO SUCH AGREEMENT. SUCH MORTGAGOR TO MAKE PAYMENTS PURSUANT TO SUCH AGREEMENT 13 FAILURE BY A WAIVER BY SUCH MORTGAGOR OF 14 SHALL CONSTITUTE THE MORATORIUM 15 PROTECTIONS SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION. S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 16
