AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to requiring commissioner of developmental disabilities to define a career path for direct support professionals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 16.39 to read as follows: 2
- S 16.39 CAREER PATH FOR DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS.
- NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISIONS OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE COMMISSION-
- 5 IN CONJUNCTION WITH NATIONAL AND STATE EXPERTS, SHALL CREATE A
- 6 PUBLIC WORKFORCE INITIATIVE TO DEFINE A CAREER PATH MODEL FOR DIRECT
- 7 SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS BY BLENDING BEST PRACTICE LEARNING INITIATIVES
- INCLUDING THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA'S COLLEGE OF DIRECT SUPPORT 8
- NEW YORK STATE DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES. FOR PROVIDER 9
- 10 ORGANIZATIONS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT ONE-DAY REGIONAL LEARNING SEMINARS ON THE TREND OF DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED SERVICES TOWARD COMPE-11
- TRAINING, THE ROLE AND VALUE OF SKILL MENTORS, AND FACILI-12 TENCY BASED

TATING DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS PORTFOLIO DEVELOPMENT.
