AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to enacting "Averyana's law"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Averyana's 2 law".
- 3 S 2. Subsections (yy) and (zz) of section 606 of the tax law, as 4 relettered by section 5 of part H of chapter 1 of the laws of 2003, are 5 relettered subsections (yyy) and (zzz) and a new subsection (xx) is 6 added to read as follows:
- 7 (XX) CREDIT FOR INSTALLATION OF SMOKE ALARMS. ANY RESIDENT OWNER OF 8 REAL PROPERTY AS DEFINED IN SECTION ONE HUNDRED TWO OF THE REAL PROPERTY 9 TAX LAW SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT AGAINST THE TAX OTHERWISE IMPOSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 10 THECOST OF PURCHASING INSTALLING CERTAIN SMOKE ALARMS WHICH INCORPORATE PHOTOELECTRIC TECHNOL-11 12 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PHOTOELECTRIC DETECTORS; DUAL PHOTOELECTRIC/IONIZATION DETECTORS; AND PHOTOELECTRIC/CARBON MONOXIDE 13
- 14 DETECTORS IN HIS OR HER RESIDENCE.
- 15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to taxable 16 years beginning on or after January 1, 2014.
