AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to commitment for intermittent sentences

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 430.20 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3 3-A. TRANSFER OF COMMITMENT FOR INTERMITTENT SENTENCES. NOTWITHSTAND-ING SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION, WHERE THE DEFENDANT AT THE TIME 4 5 OF INTERMITTENT SENTENCING RESIDES IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION WITHIN THE 6 STATE, THE SENTENCING COURT MAY TRANSFER COMMITMENT TO THE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION WHERE THE 7 DEFENDANT THE RESIDES. SENTENCING 8 JUDGE SHALL RETAIN JURISDICTION FOR ADDITIONAL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE 9 CASE.

10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 11 have become a law.
