AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to waiving civil service examination application fees for veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subdivision 5 of section 50 of the civil service law are relettered paragraphs (d) and (e) and a new paragraph (c) is added to read as follows:
- (C) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SION, THE CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT, A MUNICIPAL COMMISSION OR A REGIONAL COMMISSION SHALL WAIVE THE APPLICATION FEE OF ANY CANDIDATE WHO PROVES, 7 BY APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTARY PROOF, TO THE CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT, A MUNICIPAL COMMISSION OR A REGIONAL COMMISSION THAT HE OR SHE IS A VETER-8 AN. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE TERM "VETERAN" MEANS A 9
- 10 MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO SERVED THEREIN WHO WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER HONORABLE 11 OF WAR,
- 12 CIRCUMSTANCES FROM SUCH SERVICE, WHO IS A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED
- AN ALIEN LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE IN THE UNITED 13
- STATES AND WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AT TIME 14 THE
- 15 APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT.
