AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to exemptions pertaining to large capacity ammunition feeding devices and retired police officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision a of section 265.20 of the penal law is amended by adding a new paragraph 11-a to read as follows:

11-A. POSSESSION OF A LARGE CAPACITY AMMUNITION FEEDING DEVICE CONTAINS MORE THAN SEVEN ROUNDS OF AMMUNITION OR IS OBTAINED AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE CHAPTER OF THE LAWS OF TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN WHICH ADDED THIS PARAGRAPH AND HAS A CAPACITY OF, OR THAT CAN BE RESTORED OR CONVERTED TO ACCEPT, MORE THAN SEVEN ROUNDS OF AMMUNITION, BY AN OFF-DUTY POLICE OFFICER, OR A RETIRED POLICE OFFICER "POLICE OFFICER" IS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION THIRTY-FOUR OF OFFICER, AS SECTION 1.20 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE "PEACE OFFICER" LAW AND DEFINED IN SECTION 2.10 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAW.

12 This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as paragraphs (b) and (c) of subdivision 23 of section 265.00 of 13 14 the penal law, as amended by section 38 of chapter 1 of the laws of 15

2013, take effect.
