AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the provision of certain professional services to children's camps

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1394 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
 - 4. NOTHING IN SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED TWELVE OF THE EDUCATION LAW SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT A CHILDREN'S OVERNIGHT CAMP, SUMMER DAY CAMP, OR TRAVELING SUMMER DAY CAMP, AS DEFINED IN SECTION THIRTEEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO OF THIS ARTICLE, FROM EMPLOYING A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL TO PROVIDE SERVICES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX, ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE, ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR, ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO OR ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE OF THE EDUCATION LAW.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
