AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to prohibiting polling at
schools when in session

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY,
DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 4-104 of the election law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 7-a to read as follows:
3 7-A. NO POLLING PLACE SHALL BE LOCATED ON THE PREMISES OF ANY PUBLIC
4 OR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL OR A SCHOOL FOR PRESCHOOL
5 CHILDREN, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH I OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF
6 SECTION FORTY-FOUR HUNDRED TEN OF THE EDUCATION LAW, WHEN SUCH SCHOOL IS
7 IN SESSION.
8 S 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 2014. Effective immediate-
9 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation
10 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are
11 authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
