AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to health care proxy information on state agency websites

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 104 of the executive law is amended to read as 2 follows:
 - S 104. Departmental cooperation. (A) The secretary of state may advise with the several departments, boards, bureaus, officers, authorities, commissions and other agencies of the state which are authorized by statute to issue codes, rules or regulations, to the end that the same may, so far as possible, be uniform in style and form, be properly numbered and captioned and be free from matter which is obsolete.
- 9 (B) THE SECRETARY OF STATE, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF SHALL ADVISE WITH STATE DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, BUREAUS, AUTHORI-10 11 TIES, COMMISSIONS, DIVISIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES THAT MAINTAIN 12 WEBSITES AND THAT HAVE SIGNIFICANT PUBLIC INTERACTION IN THE FIELD OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ENSURE THAT EACH CREATES A LINK ON THEIR HOMEPAGE 13 TO 14 HEALTH CARE PROXY INFORMATION ON THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH WEBSITE.
