AN ACT to amend the transportation law, in relation to requiring safety reports to potential customers of contract carriers of passengers by motor vehicle

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 140 of the transportation law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 11 to read as follows:
 - 11. NO CONTRACT CARRIER OF PASSENGERS BY MOTOR VEHICLE, AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION NINE OF SECTION TWO OF THIS CHAPTER, SHALL ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR ANY CUSTOMER WITHOUT FIRST PROVIDING THAT CUSTOMER WITH:
- A. A COPY, IN WRITING, OF THE CONTRACT CARRIER'S THREE MOST RECENT FEDERAL SAFETY MEASUREMENT SYSTEM (SMS) SCORES; PROVIDED THAT, IF THE CONTRACT CARRIER IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE SCORES FOR ANY YEAR OR YEARS PRIOR TO TWO THOUSAND TWELVE, THE CONTRACT CARRIER MAY PROVIDE THE SCORE OR SCORES CALCULATED BY THE SAFETY STATUS MEASUREMENT SYSTEM (SAFESTAT)
- 12 FOR THAT YEAR OR YEARS; AND

- 13 B. AN EXPLANATION OF HOW THE SCORES WERE CALCULATED AND WHAT THE SCORE 14 MEANS.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
