- AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to requiring the commission to conduct annual hearings regarding certain electric corporations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 2 66-n to read as follows:

3 S 66-N. HEARINGS. 1. THE COMMISSION, NOT LESS THAN ONCE ANNUALLY, AFTER THE RECEIPT OF THE ANNUAL REPORT PROVIDED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION 4 5 SIX OF SECTION SIXTY-SIX OF THIS ARTICLE, SHALL PROMPTLY FIX A DATE FOR б COMMENCEMENT OF PUBLIC HEARINGS THEREON AND SAID PUBLIC HEARING THE 7 SHALL BE SCHEDULED AND CONDUCTED NOT LESS THAN FORTY-FIVE DAYS NOR MORE 8 RECEIPT OF SAID ANNUAL REPORT. THE THAN ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS OF 9 COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARINGS IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS 10 WITHIN THE FOLLOWING ELECTRIC CORPORATIONS' RESPECTIVE SERVICE TERRITO-11 RIES:

12 (A) CONSOLIDATED EDISON OR ANY SUCCESSOR CORPORATION: CITY OF NEW YORK 13 AND WESTCHESTER COUNTY. THE COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT AT LEAST ONE HEAR-14 ING ANNUALLY IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK AND AT LEAST ONE HEARING ANNUALLY 15 IN WESTCHESTER COUNTY. THE HEARINGS HELD IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK SHALL 16 ALTERNATE COUNTIES SO THAT AT LEAST ONE HEARING SHALL BE HELD IN EACH COUNTY EVERY FIVE YEARS. 17

18 (B) ORANGE AND ROCKLAND UTILITIES OR ANY SUCCESSOR CORPORATION: ORANGE COUNTY AND ROCKLAND COUNTY. THE COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT AT LEAST 19 20 ANNUALLY IN ONE OF THE COUNTIES AND SHALL NOT CONDUCT A ONE HEARING 21 HEARING IN THE SAME COUNTY AS THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S HEARING HELD UNDER 22 THIS SECTION.

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(C) CENTRAL HUDSON GAS AND ELECTRIC OR ANY SUCCESSOR CORPORATION: 1 ULSTER COUNTY AND DUTCHESS COUNTY OR ANY SUCCESSOR CORPORATION. 2 THE 3 COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT AT LEAST ONE HEARING ANNUALLY IN ONE OF THE 4 COUNTIES AND SHALL NOT CONDUCT A HEARING IN THE SAME COUNTY AS THE 5 PREVIOUS YEAR'S HEARING HELD UNDER THIS SECTION. 6 (D) NIAGARA MOHAWK D/B/A NATIONAL GRID OR ANY SUCCESSOR CORPORATION: 7 ALBANY COUNTY, ONONDAGA COUNTY AND ERIE COUNTY. THE COMMISSION SHALL 8 CONDUCT AT LEAST ONE HEARING ANNUALLY IN ONE OF THE COUNTIES AND SHALL 9 NOT CONDUCT A HEARING IN THE SAME COUNTY AS THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S HEARING 10 HELD UNDER THIS SECTION. 11 (E) NEW YORK STATE ELECTRIC AND GAS OR ANY SUCCESSOR CORPORATION: 12 BROOME COUNTY AND PUTNAM COUNTY. THE COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT AT LEAST ONE HEARING ANNUALLY IN ONE OF THE COUNTIES AND SHALL NOT CONDUCT A 13 14 HEARING IN THE SAME COUNTY AS THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S HEARING HELD UNDER 15 THIS SECTION. 16 (F) ROCHESTER GAS AND ELECTRIC OR ANY SUCCESSOR CORPORATION: MONROE 17 COUNTY. 18 2. FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING NOTICE AND SOLICITING PUBLIC 19 COMMENTS, AT LEAST THIRTY DAYS PRIOR TO THE PUBLIC HEARINGS REQUIRED IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE OR 20 ELECTRONIC NOTICE: (A) TO EACH COUNTY AND CITY SERVED BY SAID ELECTRIC 21 CORPORATION; (B) TO THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT 22 23 OF THE SENATE, EACH MEMBER OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE WHERE SERVICE IS PROVIDED IN SUCH MEMBER'S LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT; (C) TO THE UTILITY 24 25 INTERVENTION UNIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE; (D) BY PUBLICATION ONCE IN 26 EACH WEEK FOR FOUR SUCCESSIVE WEEKS IN A NEWSPAPER AND ON THE WEB SITE 27 OF A NEWSPAPER THAT HAS GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE SERVICE TERRITORY OF 28 SAID ELECTRIC CORPORATION; AND (E) BY PUBLICATION ON THE COMMISSION'S 29 WEB SITE. 3. (A) THE CHAIRMAN OR CHAIRWOMAN AND A MAJORITY OF THE DULY APPOINTED 30 COMMISSIONERS SHALL BE PRESENT AT THE HEARINGS REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION 31 32 ONE OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL SOLICIT PUBLIC COMMENT FROM RESIDENTIAL 33 AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS REGARDING AN ELECTRIC CORPORATION'S PERFORM-34 ANCE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: 35 (1) THE QUALITY OF ELECTRIC SERVICE; (2) THE IMPACT OF ANY COMMISSION DECISIONS IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR 36 37 REGARDING RATES FOR SERVICE OR OTHER DECISIONS AFFECTING SERVICE; 38 (3) THE ADMINISTRATION OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES BY 39 THE UTILITY; 40 (4) COMMUNICATION PROTOCOLS BETWEEN A COMPANY AND CUSTOMERS IN ARREARS ON UTILITY CHARGES REGARDING THE POTENTIAL FOR TERMINATION OF SERVICE; 41 (5) SERVICE RESTORATION PERFORMANCE AND CUSTOMER COMMUNICATION DURING 42 43 ANY OUTAGES OCCURRING IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR; AND 44 (6) ANY ADDITIONAL TOPICS OR INFORMATION THE COMMISSION DEEMS NECES-45 SARY. (B) NOT LESS THAN THIRTY DAYS PRIOR TO A PUBLIC HEARING UNDERTAKEN 46 47 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION THE COMMISSION SHALL CREATE AND PUBLISH ON ITS 48 WEB SITE A REPORT REGARDING THE ELECTRIC CORPORATION AND ITS SERVICE 49 TERRITORY THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF SUCH HEARING, WHICH PROVIDES, IN DETAIL 50 FOR THE PREVIOUS YEAR, INFORMATION INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: 51 (1) ANY COMMISSION ORDERS REGARDING RATES AND ALL OTHER DECISIONS DETERMINED RELEVANT BY THE COMMISSION; 52 (2) A LIST OF ALL ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS AND THE NUMBER OF CUSTOM-53 54 ERS UTILIZING SAID PROGRAMS;

1 (3) THE NUMBER OF CUSTOMERS WHO HAVE FALLEN INTO ARREARS OVER THE LAST 2 YEAR AND THE NUMBER OF CUSTOMERS WHOSE SERVICE WAS SUSPENDED AND/OR 3 TERMINATED DUE TO ARREARS;

4 (4) THE NUMBER OF WIDESPREAD OUTAGES THAT HAVE OCCURRED IN THE SERVICE 5 TERRITORY OF THE ELECTRIC CORPORATION DUE TO STORMS OR OTHER CAUSES 6 BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE ELECTRIC CORPORATION IN THE LAST YEAR, THE 7 NUMBER OF CUSTOMERS AFFECTED BY EACH OUTAGE, THE DURATION OF EACH OUTAGE 8 AND THE CAUSE OF EACH OUTAGE; AND

9 (5) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE COMMISSION DETERMINES IS RELEVANT TO THE 10 SERVICE TERRITORY.

11 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ALSO PUBLISH THE ANNUAL REPORT SUBMITTED 12 PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION SIXTY-SIX OF THIS ARTICLE BY THE 13 RESPECTIVE ELECTRIC CORPORATION ON THE COMMISSION'S WEB SITE.

14 S 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2014.
