AN ACT to amend the family court act, in relation to reentry of former foster children into foster care

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 355.3 of the family court act, as
2 amended by chapter 663 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 6. Successive extensions of placement under this section may be grant-
5 ed, but no placement may be made or continued beyond the respondent's
6 eighteenth birthday without [the child's] HIS OR HER consent and in no
7 event past [the child's] HIS OR HER twenty-first birthday. A RESPONDENT,
8 WHO HAS BEEN PLACED WITH A LOCAL SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT PURSUANT TO
9 SECTION 353.3 OF THIS CHAPTER, INCLUDING A DISTRICT THAT HAS AN APPROVED
10 "CLOSE TO HOME" PLAN, AND WHO DOES NOT CONSENT TO REMAIN IN CARE BEYOND
11 HIS OR HER EIGHTEENTH BIRTHDAY, AS WOULD BE REQUIRED IN ORDER TO REMAIN
12 IN CARE, MAY MOVE OR, WITH HIS OR HER CONSENT, MAY BE THE SUBJECT OF A
13 MOTION BY A SOCIAL SERVICES OFFICIAL TO REENTER FOSTER CARE IN ACCORD-
14 ANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION ONE THOUSAND NINETY-ONE OF THIS ACT.
15 S 2. Subdivision (f) of section 756-a of the family court act, as
16 added by chapter 604 of the laws of 1986, is amended to read as follows:
17 (f) Successive extensions of placement under this section may be
18 granted, but no placement may be made or continued beyond the child's
19 eighteenth birthday without his or her consent and in no event past his
20 or her twenty-first birthday. A CHILD, WHO HAS BEEN PLACED WITH A LOCAL
21 SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT PURSUANT TO SECTION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX OF
22 THIS CHAPTER, AND WHO DOES NOT CONSENT TO REMAIN IN CARE BEYOND HIS OR
23 HER EIGHTEENTH BIRTHDAY, AS WOULD BE REQUIRED IN ORDER TO REMAIN IN
24 CARE, MAY MOVE OR, WITH HIS OR HER CONSENT, MAY BE THE SUBJECT OF A

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1 MOTION BY A SOCIAL SERVICES OFFICIAL TO REENTER FOSTER CARE IN ACCORD-
2 ANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION ONE THOUSAND NINETY-ONE OF THIS ACT.

3 S 3. Section 1091 of the family court act is amended by adding a new
4 subdivision (d) to read as follows:

5 (D) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "FORMER FOSTER CARE YOUTH" SHALL
6 INCLUDE A YOUTH UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE WHO DID NOT CONSENT TO
7 REMAIN IN FOSTER CARE BEYOND HIS OR HER EIGHTEENTH BIRTHDAY, AS WOULD BE
8 REQUIRED IN ORDER TO REMAIN IN CARE, AND WHO HAD BEEN PLACED IN FOSTER
9 CARE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE THREE, SEVEN, TEN, TEN-A OR TEN-C OF THIS ACT
10 OR SECTION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT-A OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW OR WHO
11 HAS BEEN FREED FOR ADOPTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION SIX HUNDRED THIR-
12 TY-SIX OF THIS ACT OR SECTION THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE-C, THREE
13 HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR OR THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR-B OF THE SOCIAL
14 SERVICES LAW BUT WHO HAS NOT YET BEEN ADOPTED.

15 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
