AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to requiring the department of environmental conservation to notify the community boards of New York city of any new brownfield site cleanups within such community board's boundaries

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a
2 new section 27-1437 to read as follows:
3 S 27-1437. NOTIFICATION TO COMMUNITY BOARDS.
4 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY ANY COMMUNITY BOARD LOCATED IN A CITY WITH
5 A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE OF ANY NEW BROWNFIELD SITE CLEANUPS
6 LOCATED WITHIN SUCH COMMUNITY BOARD'S BOUNDARIES.
7 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after
8 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately,
9 the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation
10 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are
11 authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such
12 effective date.
