AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to authorizing the Nassau health care corporation to enter into agreements for the creation and operation of a health care delivery system network

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3405 of the public authorities law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 10. IN THE EXERCISE OF THE FOREGOING SPECIAL POWERS ESTABLISHED IN 4 THIS SECTION AND THE GENERAL POWERS SET FORTH IN SECTION THIRTY-FOUR 5 HUNDRED FOUR OF THIS TITLE, THE CORPORATION IS AUTHORIZED, IN CARRYING
- 6 OUT ITS HEALTHCARE PURPOSES, TO ENGAGE IN ARRANGEMENTS, CONTRACTS, 7 INFORMATION SHARING AND ACTIVITIES WITH PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ENTITIES AND
- 8 INDIVIDUALS, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION: JOINT VENTURES; JOINT NEGOTI-9 ATIONS WITH PHYSICIANS, HOSPITALS AND PAYORS, WHETHER SUCH NEGOTIATIONS
- 10 RESULT IN SEPARATE OR COMBINED AGREEMENTS; LEASES; AND/OR AGREEMENTS
- 11 WHICH INVOLVE DELIVERY SYSTEM NETWORK CREATION AND OPERATION, IRRESPEC-
- 12 TIVE OF THE COMPETITIVE CONSEQUENCES OF THE FOREGOING COLLABORATIVE
- 13 ACTIVITIES, AND NOTWITHSTANDING THAT THEY MAY HAVE THE EFFECT OF
- 14 DISPLACING COMPETITION IN THE PROVISION OF HOSPITAL, PHYSICIAN OR OTHER
- 15 HEALTHCARE-RELATED SERVICES, SUCH THAT THE CORPORATION AND THE PRIVATE 16 ENTITIES AND INDIVIDUALS WITH WHICH IT COLLABORATES SHALL BE IMMUNIZED
- 17 FROM LIABILITY UNDER THE FEDERAL AND STATE ANTITRUST LAWS.
- 18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
