- AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to persons authorized to visit correctional facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 146 of the correction law, as 2 amended by chapter 291 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 1. The following persons shall be authorized to visit at pleasure all 5 correctional facilities: The governor and lieutenant-governor, commis-6 sioner of general services, secretary of state, comptroller and attor-7 ney-general, members of the commission of correction, members of the 8 legislature AND ANY EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT AS REQUESTED BY THE 9 MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE IF THE MEMBER REQUESTS TO BE SO ACCOMPANIED, PROVIDED THAT SUCH REQUEST DOES NOT IMPACT UPON THE DEPARTMENT'S ABILITY 10 TO SUPERVISE, MANAGE AND CONTROL ITS FACILITIES AS DETERMINED ΒY 11 THE judges of the court of appeals, supreme court and county 12 COMMISSIONER, 13 judges, district attorneys and every clergyman or minister, as such terms are defined in section two of the religious corporations law, 14 having charge of a congregation in the county wherein any such facility 15 16 is situated. No other person not otherwise authorized by law shall be permitted to enter a correctional facility except by authority of the 17 18 commissioner of correction under such regulations as the commissioner shall prescribe. The provisions of this section shall not apply to 19 such portion of a correctional facility in which inmates under sentence of 20 21 death are confined.

22 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
