AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to liability of an owner of an aircraft for emergency response costs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 251 of the general business law, 2 as added by chapter 162 of the laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:
- 1. Except as provided in subdivision three OF THIS SECTION every owner 5 of an aircraft shall be liable and responsible for death occasioned or injuries to person or property sustained, AS WELL AS EMERGENCY RESPONSE 7 COSTS, WHETHER PRIVATE OR PUBLIC, IN RELATION TO SUCH DEATH OCCASIONED OR INJURIES TO PERSON OR PROPERTY SUSTAINED, within or above this state, 8 9 as a result of the use or operation of the aircraft in the business of the owner or otherwise, by any person using or operating the aircraft 10 with the permission, express or implied, of such owner, in any case 11 where the person using or operating the aircraft, or his estate, would 12 be liable for such death or injuries. 13
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 15 have become a law.
