AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to establishing the direct support professional credential pilot program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 13.41 to read as follows:
 - S 13.41 DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIAL PILOT PROGRAM.

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- (A) THE OFFICE SHALL INITIATE A PROGRAM TO CONTINUE TO GAIN THE EXPER-KNOWLEDGE OF THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES WORKFORCE AND OF THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION NEEDS THROUGHOUT THE FIELD. OFFICE SHALL THE IMPLEMENT A DIRECT PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIAL PILOT PROGRAM TO ASSIST AND ATTRACT INDIVIDUALS INTO THE FIELD OF DIRECT SUPPORT, ADVANCE DIRECT SUPPORT AS A CAREER AND PROFESSIONALIZE THE FIELD TO PROMOTE WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION EFFORTS, ADVANCE SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES, WHILE CREATING A CAREER LADDER WITH COMMENSURATE PAY FOR ADVANCED SKILLS, AND FURTHER HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELL BEING OF INDIVIDUALS BEING SERVED.
- (B) THERE HEREBY IS CREATED THE DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIAL PILOT PROGRAM WITHIN THE OFFICE TO ASSIST INDIVIDUALS IN THE FIELD OBTAIN A CREDENTIAL IN THEIR FIELD OF EXPERTISE.
- (1) SUCH PILOT PROGRAM SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE FOR YEARS. THEPILOT PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE STATE-OPERATED FACILITIES AND NOT-FOR-PROFIT PROVIDERS, LICENSED AND CERTIFIED BY THEOFFICE. PURPOSE OF THE PILOT PROGRAM SHALL BE TO ASSESS HOW THE ESTABLISHMENT OF STATE ACCREDITED DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIAL: (A) PROMOTES RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION EFFORTS IN THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES NOTABLY THEDIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL POSITION; (B) ENHANCES COMPETENCE IN THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES FIELD; (C) YIELDS OUALITY

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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SUPPORTS AND SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES; AND (D) ADVANCES THE HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH BY 3 STATE.

- THE OFFICE IN ADMINISTERING THE PILOT PROGRAM SHALL CONSIDER, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:
- (A) BEST PRACTICES LEARNING INITIATIVES, INCLUDING THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA'S COLLEGE OF DIRECT SUPPORT AND NEW YORK STATE DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES;
- (B) NATIONAL DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES OR CREDENTIALING 10 BASED STANDARDS AND TRAININGS;
 - (C) FACILITATING DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS PORTFOLIO DEVELOPMENT;
 - (D) THE ROLE AND VALUE OF SKILL MENTORS; AND
 - (E) CREATING A CAREER LADDER.

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- 14 (3) DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIAL MEANS A DOCUMENT ISSUED 15 AN INDIVIDUAL BY A RECOGNIZED ACCREDITING BODY ATTESTING THAT SUCH INDI-VIDUAL HAS MET THE PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE CREDENTIALING 16 PROGRAM BY THE OFFICE. 17
- (4) THE OFFICE SHALL PRODUCE A REPORT DETAILING THE 18 PROGRESS OF 19 PILOT PROGRAM, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:
- THE RATE OF RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION FOR DIRECT SUPPORT PROFES-20 21 SIONALS OF PROVIDERS PARTICIPATING IN THE PILOT PROGRAM COMPARED TO RATE FOR NON-PARTICIPATING PROVIDERS; 22
 - (B) THE NUMBER OF DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS CREDENTIALED; AND
- 24 (C) THE ENHANCEMENT OF QUALITY SUPPORTS AND SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS 25 WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.
- 26 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 27 have become a law.
