AN ACT to amend the not-for-profit corporation law, in relation to the sale of property to land banks

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subparagraph 2 of paragraph (a) of section 1603 of the  
2 not-for-profit corporation law, as added by chapter 257 of the laws of  
3 2011, is amended to read as follows:  
4     (2) the number of members of the board of directors, which shall  
5 consist of an odd number of members, and shall be not less than five  
6 members nor more than [eleven] FIFTEEN members;  
7     S 2. Paragraph (i) of section 1616 of the not-for-profit corporation  
8 law, as added by chapter 257 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as  
9 follows:  
10     (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, in the  
11 event that no municipality elects to tender a bid at a judicially  
12 ordered sale pursuant to the provisions of section eleven hundred thir-  
13 ty-six of the real property tax law OR SALE PURSUANT TO A COUNTY CHAR-  
14 TER, CITY CHARTER, ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, OR SPECIAL LAW, the land bank  
15 may tender a bid at such sale in an amount equal to the total amount of  
16 all municipal claims and liens which were the basis for the judgment. In  
17 the event of such tender by the land bank the property shall be deemed  
18 sold to the land bank regardless of any bids by any other third parties.  
19 The bid of the land bank shall be paid as to its form, substance, and  
20 timing according to such agreement as is mutually acceptable to the  
21 plaintiff and the land bank. The obligation of the land bank to perform  
22 in accordance with such agreement shall be deemed to be in full satis-  
23 faction of the municipal claim which was the basis for the judgment. The  
24 land bank, as purchaser at such JUDICIALLY ORDERED sale OR SALE PURSUANT

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1 TO A COUNTY CHARTER, CITY CHARTER, ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, OR SPECIAL LAW,  
2 shall take and forever thereafter have, an absolute title to the proper-  
3 ty sold, free and discharged of all tax and municipal claims, liens,  
4 mortgages, charges and estates of whatsoever kind. The deed to the land  
5 bank shall be executed, acknowledged and delivered within thirty days of  
6 the sale.

7 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
