AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to establishing a 5 minute grace period for certain parking violations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1205 to read as follows:
- S 1205. GRACE PERIOD FOR CERTAIN PARKING VIOLATIONS. WHEN PARKING PROHIBITED BY THIS ARTICLE OR BY LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, ORDER, RULE OR 5 REGULATION UPON THE EXPIRATION OF A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME TIME, NO PENALTY SHALL BE IMPOSED, NOR SHALL ANY NOTICE OF 7 VIOLATION BE ISSUED TO AN OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE UNLESS 8 FIVE MINUTES HAVE ELAPSED FROM THE TIME POSTED ON THE APPROPRIATE 9 TRAFFIC SIGN, SIGNAL, MARKING OR PARKING METER THAT DEMARCATES PROHIBITED PERIOD OF PARKING. THE ELAPSED TIME SHALL BE MEASURED FROM 10 THE TIME POSTED ON SUCH TRAFFIC SIGN, SIGNAL, MARKING OR PARKING 11 THAT DEMARCATES THE PROHIBITED PERIOD OF PARKING TO THE TIME PUBLISHED 12 ON THE NOTICE OF VIOLATION, WITH THE PERIOD UP 13 TO AND INCLUDING THE POSTED PROHIBITED PERIOD NOT CONSTITUTING A VIOLATION 14 MINUTES PAST
- 15 OF THE PROHIBITIONS POSTED ON THE TRAFFIC SIGN, SIGNAL, MARKING OR PARK-16 ING METER.
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
