AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to information returns relating to payments made in settlement of payment card and third party network transactions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 1 of section 1703 of the tax law, as added by section 1 of part E of chapter 57 of the laws of 2010, 3 is amended to read as follows:
- Any information received by the department on an information return filed pursuant to this section, concerning a person who is not subject to tax in New York, or is not subject to any requirement imposed by or pursuant to the authority of this chapter, may not be used by the department. The department shall not redisclose any information received on an information return filed pursuant to this section, EXCEPT THAT IT 10 MAY DISCLOSE TO THE COMMISSIONER OF FINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, FOR PURPOSE OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF LAWS RELATING TO TAXES OR CHARGES COLLECTED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF FINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, INFOR-12 MATION RECEIVED ON SUCH RETURNS CONCERNING ANY PERSON OR ENTITY 13
- ADDRESS OR THAT IS A NEW YORK CITY TAXPAYER OR THAT IS 14 NEW YORK CITY 15 REQUIRED TO PAY NEW YORK CITY TAXES AND/OR CHARGES OR THAT IS SUBJECT TO
- ANY REPORTING REQUIREMENT PURSUANT TO NEW YORK CITY TAX LAWS. 16
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
