AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the state smart growth public infrastructure criteria

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 6-0107 of the environmental conservation law, as added by chapter 433 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:
- In addition to meeting other criteria and requirements of law governing approval, development, financing and state aid for the construction of new or expanded public infrastructure or the reconstruction thereof, no state infrastructure agency shall approve, under-7 8 support or finance a public infrastructure project, including providing grants, awards, loans or assistance programs, unless, to the 9 extent practicable, it is consistent with the relevant criteria speci-10 fied in subdivision two of this section. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS 11 OF THIS SUBDIVISION OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS 12 ARTICLE 13 CONTRARY, PROJECTS FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, REPAIR OR 14 IMPROVEMENT OF EXISTING PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES OR EXISTING LIBRARY 15 FACILITIES, AND PROJECTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW OR EXPANDED PUBLIC 16 SCHOOL OR LIBRARY FACILITIES IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE 17 HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND INHABITANTS OR MORE, SHALL NOT BE DEEMED 18 PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTI-19
- 20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
