- AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to mandatory health insurance coverage for prosthetic devices

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph 30 to read as follows:

3 (30) EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR 4 COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR DURABLE MEDICAL 5 EQUIPMENT SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES THAT ARE INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE б AND HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022 THAT IS EQUIVALENT TO THE 7 8 COVERAGE PROVIDED FOR DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT. THIS SHALL INCLUDE 9 COVERAGE NOT ONLY FOR THE PROVISION OF A PROSTHETIC DEVICE REQUIRED TO BE WORN OR USED BY A POLICY HOLDER BUT ALSO THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF 10 A PROSTHETIC DEVICE REQUIRED TO BE WORN OR USED BY A POLICY 11 HOLDER. 12 COVERAGE SHALL INCLUDE EXPENSES FOR ASSESSMENT, EVALUATION, TREATMENT, MANAGEMENT, AND FOLLOW-UP CARE. COVERAGE SHALL NOT BE DENIED 13 IF THE 14 POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC DEVICE IS THE MOST APPROPRIATE MODEL THAT ADEOUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF THE 15 POLICY HOLDER. THE TERM "PROSTHETIC DEVICE" AS USED IN THIS PARAGRAPH INCLUDES 16 AN ARTIFICIAL LIMB BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE SHOES OR ANY OTHER ARTICLE 17 18 CONSIDERED AS ORDINARY WEARING APPAREL, WHETHER OR NOT SPECIALLY 19 CONSTRUCTED. THE TERM "POLICY HOLDER" AS USED IN THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL 20 MEAN A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO RESIDES IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK

3 S 2. Subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by 4 adding a new paragraph 19 to read as follows:

5 EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR (19) 6 COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR DURABLE MEDICAL 7 EQUIPMENT SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES THAT ARE 8 INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022 THAT IS EQUIVALENT TO THE 9 10 COVERAGE PROVIDED FOR DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT. THIS SHALL INCLUDE COVERAGE NOT ONLY FOR THE PROVISION OF A PROSTHETIC DEVICE REQUIRED TO 11 BE WORN OR USED BY A POLICY HOLDER BUT ALSO THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF 12 A PROSTHETIC DEVICE REQUIRED TO BE WORN OR USED BY A POLICY HOLDER. 13 COVERAGE SHALL INCLUDE EXPENSES FOR ASSESSMENT, EVALUATION, TREATMENT, 14 MANAGEMENT, AND FOLLOW-UP CARE. COVERAGE SHALL NOT BE DENIED 15 IF THE 16 POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC DEVICE IS THE MOST APPROPRIATE MODEL THAT ADEQUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF THE POLICY 17 HOLDER. THE TERM "PROSTHETIC DEVICE" AS USED IN THIS PARAGRAPH INCLUDES 18 19 AN ARTIFICIAL LIMB BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE SHOES OR ANY OTHER ARTICLE 20 CONSIDERED AS ORDINARY WEARING APPAREL, WHETHER OR NOT SPECIALLY 21 CONSTRUCTED. THE TERM "POLICY HOLDER" AS USED IN THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL MEAN A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO RESIDES IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK 22 AND WHOSE MEDICAL NEED FOR SUCH PROSTHETIC DEVICE RESULTED FROM AN INJU-23 RY SUFFERED IN THE LINE OF DUTY WHILE SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES. 24

25 S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new 26 subsection (oo) to read as follows:

27 (OO) EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR 28 COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR DURABLE MEDICAL 29 EQUIPMENT SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES THAT ARE INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND 30 HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022 THAT IS EQUIVALENT TO THE 31 32 COVERAGE PROVIDED FOR DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT. THIS SHALL INCLUDE COVERAGE NOT ONLY FOR THE PROVISION OF A PROSTHETIC DEVICE REQUIRED TO 33 BE WORN OR USED BY A POLICY HOLDER BUT ALSO THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF 34 A PROSTHETIC DEVICE REQUIRED TO BE WORN OR USED BY A POLICY HOLDER. 35 COVERAGE SHALL INCLUDE EXPENSES FOR ASSESSMENT, EVALUATION, TREATMENT, 36 37 MANAGEMENT, AND FOLLOW-UP CARE. COVERAGE SHALL NOT BE DENIED IF THE 38 POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC DEVICE IS THE MOST 39 APPROPRIATE MODEL THAT ADEQUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF THE POLICY 40 THE TERM "PROSTHETIC DEVICE" AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION HOLDER. MEAN A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO RESIDES IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK 44 45 AND WHOSE MEDICAL NEED FOR SUCH PROSTHETIC DEVICE RESULTED FROM AN INJU-RY SUFFERED IN THE LINE OF DUTY WHILE SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES. 46

47 S 4. This act shall take effect May 1, 2015 and shall apply to all 48 policies and contracts issued, renewed, altered, or amended on or after 49 such effective date.
