AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to mandatory health insurance coverage for prosthetic devices

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph 30 to read as follows:
- 3 (30) EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR DURABLE MEDICAL COMPREHENSIVE 5 EQUIPMENT SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES THAT 6 FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND INTENDED HABILITATIVE 7 PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022 IS EQUIVALENT THATCOVERAGE PROVIDED FOR DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT. COVERAGE SHALL NOT BE DENIED IF THE POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC DEVICE 9 10 IS THE MOST APPROPRIATE MODEL THAT ADEQUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF 11 THE POLICY HOLDER.  - EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES THAT INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022 THAT IS EQUIVALENT TO THE COVERAGE PROVIDED FOR DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT. COVERAGE SHALL NOT BE DENIED IF THE POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC DEVICE IS THE MOST APPROPRIATE MODEL THAT ADEQUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF POLICY HOLDER.
