AN ACT directing the state education department to conduct a study concerning the cost of installing hard-wired carbon monoxide detectors in schools

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The state education department shall conduct a study to
2 examine, evaluate and make recommendations concerning the cost of
3 installing hard-wired carbon monoxide detectors in every elementary and
4 secondary school building within the state. Such carbon monoxide detec-
5 tors shall meet the manufacture, design and installation standards
6 established by the New York state uniform fire prevention and building
7 code council pursuant to section three hundred seventy-eight of the
8 executive law. The department may study the cost of installing combina-
9 tion smoke and carbon monoxide detectors where such detector meets the
10 manufacture, design and installation standards established by the New
11 York state uniform fire prevention and building code council pursuant to
12 section three hundred seventy-eight of the executive law. The department
13 shall also provide recommendations on optional methods of funding the
14 installation of hard-wired carbon monoxide detectors in every elementary
15 and secondary school building within the state.
16 S 2. The state education department shall report the findings of such
17 study to the governor and the legislature, on or before July 31, 2014.
18 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
