AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to establishing the task force for the review of rules, regulations and public authorities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new article 3-B to 2 read as follows: 3 ARTICLE 3-B

ARTICLE 3-B REVIEW OF RULES, REGULATIONS AND PUBLIC AUTHORITIES

6 SECTION 39-G. TASK FORCE FOR THE REVIEW OF RULES, REGULATIONS AND PUBLIC 7 AUTHORITIES.

8 TASK FORCE FOR THE REVIEW OF RULES, REGULATIONS AND PUBLIC 39-G. S 9 AUTHORITIES. 1. ON OR BEFORE MARCH FIRST IN EACH YEAR THAT ENDS WITH A 10 FOUR, THERE SHALL BE ESTABLISHED A TASK FORCE FOR THE REVIEW OF RULES, REGULATIONS AND PUBLIC AUTHORITIES. SUCH TASK FORCE SHALL EXAMINE, EVAL-11 12 UATE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING THE UTILITY OF AND THE NECESSI-13 TY FOR EACH STATE RULE, REGULATION AND PUBLIC AUTHORITY.

2. THE TASK FORCE FOR THE REVIEW OF RULES, REGULATIONS AND PUBLIC 14 15 AUTHORITIES SHALL BE COMPOSED OF ELEVEN MEMBERS APPOINTED AS FOLLOWS: THREE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY 16 THE TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF 17 STATE COMPTROLLER; THE SENATE; TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF 18 THE ASSEMBLY; ONE 19 APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE; AND ONE MEMBER MEMBER 20 APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE ASSEMBLY. THEGOVERNOR SHALL 21 DESIGNATE THE CHAIR OF THE TASK FORCE FROM AMONG HIS OR HER APPOINTEES.

1 3. THE TASK FORCE SHALL HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS AND SHALL HAVE THE POWERS 2 OF A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO THE LEGISLATIVE LAW.

4. THE MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE SHALL RECEIVE NO COMPENSATION FOR
4 THEIR SERVICES, BUT SHALL BE ALLOWED THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES
5 INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

5. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT FEASIBLE, THE TASK FORCE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO
REQUEST AND RECEIVE AND SHALL UTILIZE AND BE PROVIDED WITH SUCH FACILI8 TIES, RESOURCES AND DATA OF ANY COURT, DEPARTMENT, DIVISION, BOARD,
9 BUREAU, COMMISSION, OR AGENCY OF THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION
10 OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY THEREOF AS IT MAY REASONABLY REQUEST TO CARRY OUT
11 PROPERLY ITS POWERS AND DUTIES PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

6. THE TASK FORCE SHALL, ON OR BEFORE JANUARY FIRST IN EACH YEAR THAT NDS WITH A FIVE, SUBMIT A REPORT OF ITS FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR, THE STATE COMPTROLLER AND THE LEGISLA-TURE, AND SHALL SUBMIT WITH SUCH REPORT SUCH LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT ITS RECOMMENDATIONS. THE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE REPEAL OF ANY UNNECESSARY RULE OR REGULATION SHALL BE BINDING UNLESS BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION THE LEGISLATURE SHALL REJECT THE RECOM-MENDATION IN WHOLE OR IN PART.

20 7. EACH TASK FORCE SHALL BE DISSOLVED UPON SUBMISSION OF ITS REPORT 21 PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX OF THIS SECTION.

22 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
