AN ACT to amend the economic development law, in relation to requiring the division for small-business to compile an annual report on the state of small businesses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 134 of the economic development law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
3 12. COMPILE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE STATE OF SMALL BUSINESSES, PARTICULARLY
4 THOSE WITH TWENTY-FIVE EMPLOYEES OR LESS WHICH SHALL BE KNOWN AS
5 MICRO-BUSINESSES UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL, ON OR
6 BEFORE FEBRUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER,
7 SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE
8 SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY A REPORT THAT SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED
9 TO, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR:
10 (A) THE GROWTH AND ECONOMIC TRENDS OF SMALL BUSINESSES WHICH MAY BE
11 CATEGORIZED BY VARIOUS SMALL BUSINESS SIZES AND/OR SECTORS;
12 (B) THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE VARIOUS SMALL BUSINESS SECTORS THROUGH-
13 OUT NEW YORK STATE, WHICH MAY BE CATEGORIZED BY VARIOUS SMALL BUSINESS
14 SIZES;
15 (C) SUGGESTIONS TO IMPROVE THE EFFICIENCY OF EXISTING LOAN PROGRAMS;
16 (D) SUGGESTIONS TO IMPROVE SMALL BUSINESS GROWTH;
17 (E) STATISTICAL AND ECONOMIC ANALYSIS OF THE STATE OF SMALL BUSINESSES
18 BY VARIOUS SMALL BUSINESS SIZES AND/OR SECTORS;
19 (F) AN ANALYSIS OF THE LOCAL AND STATE FINES AND PENALTIES THAT SMALL
20 BUSINESSES INCUR WHICH MAY BE CATEGORIZED BY VARIOUS SMALL BUSINESS
21 SIZES AND/OR SECTORS; AND

1 (G) AN ANALYSIS OF THE IMPACT OF LOCAL AND STATE REGULATIONS AND LAWS
2 THAT SMALL BUSINESSES MUST ADHERE TO, WHICH MAY BE CATEGORIZED BY VARI-
3 OUS SMALL BUSINESS SIZES AND/OR SECTORS.

4 THE DIVISION SHALL COLLABORATE WITH OTHER STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES TO
5 DEVELOP THE ANNUAL REPORT. THE OFFICE SHALL MAINTAIN AND PUBLISH SUCH
6 INFORMATION ON THE SMALL BUSINESS DIRECTORY WEBPAGE IN A MANNER THAT
7 ALLOWS INDIVIDUALS TO SEARCH THE REPORT BY NAME, DATE, OR TYPE OF
8 STATISTICS. THE FORMAT OF THE ANNUAL REPORT SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN
9 CONSULTATION WITH VARIOUS SMALL BUSINESS OWNERS TO ENSURE THE INFORMA-
10 TION COLLECTED, ANALYZED, AND PUBLISHED FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDI-
11 VISION IS REPRESENTATIVE OF ALL SMALL BUSINESSES IN THE STATE.

12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
