- AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to designating additional participating agencies for purposes of agency assisted voter registration

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of section 5-211 of the election law, 2 as amended by chapter 265 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as 3 follows:

Each agency designated as a participating agency under the provisions 4 of this section shall implement and administer a program of distribution 5 б of voter registration forms pursuant to the provisions of this section. 7 The following offices which provide public assistance and/or provide state funded programs primarily engaged in providing services to persons 8 9 with disabilities are hereby designated as voter registration agencies: 10 designated as the state agencies which provide public assistance are the office of children and family services, the office of temporary and disability assistance and the department of health. Also designated as 11 12 public assistance agencies are all agencies of 13 local government that 14 provide such assistance. Designated as state agencies that provide programs primarily engaged in providing services to people with disabil-15 16 ities are the department of labor, office for the aging, division of 17 veterans' affairs, office of mental health, office of vocational and educational services for individuals with disabilities, commission on 18 quality of care for the mentally disabled, office [of mental retardation 19

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and] FOR PEOPLE WITH developmental disabilities, commission for the 1 2 blind, office of alcoholism and substance abuse services, the office of 3 advocate for the disabled and all offices which administer programs the 4 established or funded by such agencies. Additional state agencies desig-5 nated as voter registration offices are the department of state and the 6 division of workers' compensation. Such agencies shall be required to 7 offer voter registration forms to persons upon initial application for 8 services, renewal or recertification for services and change of address relating to such services. Such agencies shall also be responsible for 9 10 providing assistance to applicants in completing voter registration 11 forms, receiving and transmitting the completed application form from all applicants who wish to have such form transmitted to the appropriate 12 13 board of elections. The state board of elections shall, together with 14 representatives of the department of defense, develop and implement 15 procedures for including recruitment offices of the armed forces of the United States as voter registration offices when such offices are so designated by federal law. The state board shall also make request of 16 17 18 the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service to include 19 applications for registration by mail with any materials which are given to new citizens. All institutions of the state university of New York 20 21 the city university of New York, shall, at the beginning of the and 22 school year, and again in January of a year in which the president of the United States is to be elected, provide an application for registra-23 24 tion to each student in each such institution. The state board of 25 elections may, by regulation, grant a waiver from any or all of the 26 requirements of this section to any office or program of an agency, if 27 it determines that it is not feasible for such office or program to administer such requirement. ALSO DESIGNATED AS PARTICIPATING AGENCIES 28 ARE ALL PUBLIC LIBRARIES, WHICH SHALL BE REOUIRED TO OFFER VOTER REGIS-29 30 TRATION FORMS TO PERSONS EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER UPON INITIAL APPLICATION FOR A LIBRARY CARD. ALSO DESIGNATED AS PARTICIPATING AGEN-31 32 CIES ARE ALL LOCAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES, WHICH SHALL BE REQUIRED TO OFFER 33 REGISTRATION FORMS TO PERSONS UPON INITIAL VOTER APPLICATION FOR SERVICES OR RECERTIFICATION FOR SERVICES. ALSO DESIGNATED AS PARTICIPAT-34 35 ING AGENCIES ARE ALL PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS, WHICH SHALL BE REQUIRED TO OFFER VOTER REGISTRATION FORMS TO ALL SENIORS UPON THEIR GRADUATION. 36 37 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 38 shall have become a law; provided that the state board of elections it 39 is authorized to promulgate any rules necessary to implement this act on 40 or before its effective date.
