Introduced by Sen. HOYLMAN -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Rules

AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, relation to requiring the use of seatbelts by passengers in taxicabs and for-hire vehicles in the city of New York and requiring operators to display a notice informing passengers of such requirement

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 19-529 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding two new subdivisions e and f to read as follows:
- E. (1) EVERY TAXICAB AND FOR-HIRE VEHICLE SHALL DISPLAY A NOTICE WITH-IN THE TAXICAB OR FOR-HIRE VEHICLE WHICH STATES IN CONSPICUOUS LETTERING OF AT LEAST SEVENTY-TWO POINT BOLDFACE TYPE:

NEW YORK STATE LAW REOUIRES ALL PASSENGERS TO BE RESTRAINED BY SEAT AND/OR SHOULDER BELT SYSTEMS.

- (2) SUCH SIGN SHALL BE PLACED IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION AND IN A CONSPIC-UOUS PLACE WHERE IT CAN EASILY BE READ BY THE PASSENGERS IN THE OR FOR-HIRE VEHICLE.
- (3) ANY TAXICAB OR FOR-HIRE VEHICLE WHICH VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY, NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION.
- (1)ALL PASSENGERS IN A TAXICAB OR FOR-HIRE VEHICLE SHALL BE RESTRAINED BY A SAFETY BELT APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER. ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A CIVIL FINE OF UP TO FIFTY DOLLARS.
- (2) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT APPLY TO A WITH A PHYSICALLY DISABLING CONDITION WHOSE PHYSICAL DISABILITY WOULD PREVENT APPROPRIATE RESTRAINT IN SUCH SAFETY SEAT OR SAFETY BELT 22 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, SUCH CONDITION IS DULY CERTIFIED BY A PHYSICIAN WHO 23 SHALL STATE THE NATURE OF THE HANDICAP, AS  ${ t WELL}$ AS THE REASON SUCH 24 RESTRAINT IS INAPPROPRIATE.
