AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to enacting the "Smoke Free Parks Act of 2014"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Smoke Free Parks Act of 2014".
- 3 S 2. Section 1399-o-1 of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
- SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED AND NO PERSON SHALL SMOKE IN ANY SMOKING PUBLIC PARK IN THIS STATE. THE GOVERNING BODY OF A MUNICIPALITY OR POLI-7 TICAL SUBDIVISION WHICH OPERATES OR MAINTAINS A PUBLIC PARK OR THE STATE 8 AGENCY OR OTHER ENTITY WHICH OPERATES OR MAINTAINS A STATE PARK 9 DISPLAY A SIGN AT THE ENTRANCE OF SUCH PUBLIC PARK STATING "ALL NEW YORK STATE PARKS ARE NOW SMOKE-FREE PARKS". ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE 10 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF 11 NOT MORE
- THAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS. 12
