AN ACT to authorize the Middletown-Hardenburgh fire district to extend the fire district into the village of Margaretville

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of article 11 of  
2 the town law, commencing upon the effective date of a resolution adopted  
3 by the town boards of Middletown and Hardenburgh, in the county of Dela-  
4 ware, pursuant to section 170 of the town law governing fire districts,  
5 the boundary of the Middletown-Hardenburgh fire district shall be  
6 extended to include the territorial boundaries of the village of Margar-  
7 etville for the purposes of fire protection.
- 8     S 2. Upon the completion by the town boards of Middletown and Harden-  
9 burgh of the proceedings authorized by section one of this act, the fire  
10 district shall include the village of Margaretville, and the Middle-  
11 town-Hardenburgh fire district shall continue to have all of the powers,  
12 duties, and responsibilities it possessed prior to the enactment of this  
13 act, and shall be subject to all of the limitations, procedures, and  
14 restrictions set forth in such section.
- 15     S 3. On and after the completion of proceedings authorized by section  
16 one of this act, the fire district shall maintain its existence and  
17 continue to maintain apparatus, appliances and facilities as it did  
18 before the enactment of this act. Nothing in this act shall give the  
19 village of Margaretville control over the fire district beyond the  
20 provisions of the town law.
- 21     S 4. The towns of Hardenburgh and Middletown, village of Margaret-  
22 ville, and the Middletown-Hardenburgh fire district shall use the exist-  
23 ing procedures of section 170 of the town law for adoption of the resol-  
24 utions to extend the Middletown-Hardenburgh fire district into the  
25 village of Margaretville.
- 26     S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
