AN ACT in relation to authorizing the village of Southampton, county of Suffolk to hire Gregg Keghlian to fill a full-time competitive position with the village of Southampton police department

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 58 of the civil service law or any other law to the contrary, the village of Southampton, county of Suffolk, is hereby authorized and directed upon the approval of the village board of trustees and the police chief of the village of Southampton, to appoint Gregg Keghlian, who is currently employed as a full-time court officer and part-time police officer with the police department of the village of Southampton, to a full-time competitive position as a police officer with the police department of such village.

9 S 2. Gregg Keghlian shall be otherwise subject to the merit and 10 fitness provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time 11 police officers.

12 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
