AN ACT to amend chapter 566 of the laws of 1967, relating to providing for the apportionment of funds to certain special school districts, in relation to eliminating reference to such union free school district number 13; and to repeal chapter 559 of the laws of 1972, relating to establishing union free school district number 13 in the town of Greenburgh in the county of Westchester

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 559 of the laws of 1972, relating to establishing union free school district number 13 in the town of Greenburgh in the county of Westchester, is REPEALED.
- S 2. Any funds remaining in the possession of the union free school district number 13, town of Greenburgh, county of Westchester, after all 5 6 its debts and obligations have been paid, shall be paid over to the 7 board of cooperative educational services of the sole supervisory district of the county of Westchester (Southern Westchester BOCES) for 9 the services provided to such union free school district pursuant to 10 Though such union free school district section three of this act. 11 number 13 be dissolved, section 1518 of the education law shall be deemed to apply, and it shall continue to exist in law for the purpose of providing for and paying all its just debts; provided that the board 12 13 of cooperative educational services of the sole supervisory district of 14 the county of Westchester (Southern Westchester BOCES) shall be author-15 ized to act on behalf of the school district pursuant to section three 16 17 of this act.
- 18 S 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 19 during any period in which there is no duly constituted board of educa-20 tion of union free school district number 13, town of Greenburgh, county 21 of Westchester, Southern Westchester BOCES shall be authorized to take

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any actions on behalf of the school district that are reasonably necessary to complete the closedown and dissolution of the district that board of education would have, including but not limited to, the power to enter contracts, pay outstanding debts, sell school district property with approval of the commissioner, and to bill for and receive 5 6 any reimbursement due and owing for tuition pursuant to article 81 of 7 the education law or any other provision of law for services rendered to students on or before the school district ceased operation on July 1, 9 2011 and reimbursement for closedown costs determined pursuant to this 10 section. The Southern Westchester BOCES shall review the business 11 records of the school district, including any claims, invoices and bills submitted to the school district during any period in which there was no 12 duly constituted board of education and shall audit any expenses or 13 14 claims, based on invoices, bills or other documentation, that were not 15 included in an audited financial statement or financial reports 16 ted to the department of education by the school district, to determine if such expenses or claims are duplicative of claims previously submit-17 18 ted for reimbursement and, if not, whether they are supported by 19 documentation that would substantiate a claim that the expense was 20 incurred by the school district or is otherwise an outstanding debt of 21 the school district. Such audit may be conducted by the claims auditor 22 the BOCES or, with the approval of the commissioner of education, by an independent auditor retained by the BOCES. The BOCES shall report to 23 the department of education any audited claims that were not included in 24 25 audited financial statement or financial report, together with the documentation supporting such claims. Reimbursement for costs incurred 26 27 for closedown of the school district shall include only: (i) any allowable costs approved by the commissioner of education that were included 28 29 the audited financial statement and financial reports submitted by 30 the school district in conformity with the financial reporting requirements; (ii) additional allowable costs, incurred in the 2010-2011 school 31 32 year or subsequently during the closedown period, that are approved by 33 the commissioner of education in accordance with the reimbursable cost manual in effect for the 2010-2011 school year and relate to claims that 34 were audited by the Southern Westchester BOCES pursuant to this section 35 36 and are based on supporting documentation that would substantiate a 37 claim that the expense was incurred by the school district and not duplicative of claims previously reimbursed; and (iii) the actual documented cost to the Southern Westchester BOCES of carrying out its duties 38 39 40 under the provisions of this section to close down the school district, 41 as approved by the commissioner of education based on documentation that 42 such costs were necessary to carry out such duties, shall be included in 43 a closedown rate payable by each school district or social 44 district responsible for tuition for students attending the special act 45 school district in the 2010-2011 school year. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule or regulation to the contrary, such closedown 46 47 rate may be payable in three installments which shall be as 48 practicable, over three consecutive years after the closedown rate is established. In such capacity, such board of cooperative educational 49 services and its officers and employees shall be entitled to defense and 50 51 indemnification by the state pursuant to section 18 of the public offi-52 53

S 4. The records of union free school district number 13, town of Greenburgh, county of Westchester, shall be forwarded to the district superintendent of schools of the Southern Westchester BOCES for preservation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, such

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31 32 records shall be deemed to be records of the Southern Westchester BOCES for purposes of the management and disposition of such records and local government records management grants pursuant to section 57.35 of the arts and cultural affairs law.

- S 5. The territory comprising the union free school district number 13, town of Greenburgh, county of Westchester, shall revert to and become part of the Irvington union free school district in the county of Westchester.
- 9 S 6. Section 1 of chapter 566 of the laws of 1967, relating to provid-10 ing for the apportionment of funds to certain special school districts, 11 as amended by chapter 213 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as 12 follows:
  - Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3602 and 3602-b of the education law, and in lieu of any apportionments to which such school districts might otherwise be entitled under such sections or under any other provisions of law, the commissioner of education is hereby authorized to include the following school districts in the annuapportionment of public moneys and such apportionment shall be computed in accordance with the provisions of sections two, four of this act: union free school district number twenty-seven of the town of Dryden, Tompkins county; union free school district number eight of the town of Canaan, Columbia county; union free school districts numbers ten, eleven[,] AND twelve [and thirteen] of the town of Greenburgh, Westchester county; union free school districts numbers three and four of the town of Mount Pleasant, Westchester county; union free school district number six, Blythedale, town of Mount Pleasant, Westchester county; and Randolph Children's Home union free school district of the town of Randolph, Cattaraugus county; West Park union free school district number two, town of Esopus, Ulster county; common school district number seven of the town of Oyster Bay, Nassau county; and union free school district number three, town of Riverhead, Suffolk county.
- 33 S 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
