AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to expanding that portion of the state highway system designated as the "Wyoming County Veterans Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 342-xxx of the highway law, as added by chapter 2 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:
 - S 342-xxx. Portion of THE state highway system to be designated as the "Wyoming County Veterans Memorial Highway". [That] ALL THAT portion of THE state HIGHWAY SYSTEM KNOWN AS UNITED STATES route 20A [located within the boundaries of the county of Wyoming from the intersection of state route 98 to the intersection of state route 246, a distance of approximately sixteen and one-tenth miles] BEGINNING AT COUNTY LINE OF THE COUNTY OF WYOMING AND ENDING AT THE EASTERN COUNTY LINE OF THE COUNTY OF WYOMING, shall be designated and known as "Wyoming County Veterans Memorial Highway".
 - 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act; provided that, to avoid any confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.
