- AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to the beginning farmer revolving loan fund program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 328 of the agriculture and markets law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

3 "BEGINNING FARMER" SHALL MEAN A FARMER WHO HAS NOT PRODUCED AN 5. 4 "AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT" AS DEFINED IN THIS SECTION, FOR MORE THAN TEN CONSECUTIVE YEARS, AND WHO WILL MATERIALLY AND SUBSTANTIALLY PARTICIPATE 5 6 THE PRODUCTION OF AN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT WITHIN A REGION OF THE IN 7 STATE.

8 S 2. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 9 section 330-a to read as follows:

10 330-A. BEGINNING FARMER REVOLVING LOAN PROGRAM. 1. THE COMMISSIONER S SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A BEGINNING FARMER REVOLVING LOAN 11 PROGRAM 12 TO PROVIDE LOW INTEREST LOANS TO BEGINNING FARMERS FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUPPORTING BEGINNING FARMERS, ENCOURAGING THE GROWTH OF SMALL AGRIBUSI-13 14 NESS, PRESERVING FARMLAND AS A WORKING AGRICULTURAL LANDSCAPE, AND 15 PROVIDING OPEN SPACE BENEFITS FOR ALL RESIDENTS OF THE STATE. PROPERLY MANAGED FARMLAND HAS BEEN DEMONSTRATED TO BE THE BEST ENVIRONMENTAL 16 USAGE OF LAND FOR WATERSHED PROTECTION, SO IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF 17 THE STATE TO MAINTAIN AGRICULTURAL LAND. SUCH PROGRAM 18 SHALL, FROM ANY APPROPRIATION MADE AVAILABLE FOR THIS PURPOSE, PROVIDE LOW INTEREST 19 LOANS TO BEGINNING FARMERS AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DEEM TO BE ELIGIBLE 20 21 PURSUANT TO RULE OR REGULATION.

22 2. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE 23 PURPOSE OF CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING ESTAB-24 LISHING:
