AN ACT to amend the real property tax law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to enacting the "sewage flooding prevention act"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "sewage flooding prevention act".
 - 2. The real property tax law is amended by adding a new section 471 to read as follows:
- S 471. ABATEMENT OF TAXES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CHECK VALVES FOR IN CITIES WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE. SEWER IMPROVEMENTS 1. IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, ANY OWNER OF A

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- 8 DWELLING WHO INSTALLS A CHECK VALVE DEVICE TO PREVENT SEWAGE FROM BACK-9 FLOWING INTO SUCH DWELLING SHALL RECEIVE AN ABATEMENT OF TAXES 10 PROPERTY EOUALING ONE-HALF, UP TO TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS TOWARDS THE COST OF PURCHASING AND INSTALLING SUCH DEVICE. 11
- 2. ANY NOT-FOR-PROFIT ENTITY WHICH OWNS A BUILDING OF ANY TYPE IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE AND WHICH DWELLING INSTALLS A CHECK VALVE DEVICE TO PREVENT SEWAGE FROM BACK-FLOWING SUCH BUILDING OR DWELLING SHALL RECEIVE AN ABATEMENT OF WATER AND SEWER CHARGES EQUALING ONE-HALF OF THE COST OF PURCHASING AND INSTALLING DEVICE, UP TO TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS. 17
- 18 FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "DWELLING" SHALL MEAN 19 ANY BUILDING, STRUCTURE OR PORTION THEREOF WHICH IS OCCUPIED IN WHOLE OR 20 IN PART AS A HOME, RESIDENCE OR SLEEPING PLACE FOR ONE OR MORE 21 BEINGS.
- 22 4. NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION SHALL THE23 PROMULGATE ANY RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF 24 THIS SECTION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, IDENTIFYING APPROPRIATE 25 CHECK VALVE SYSTEMS.
- 26 S 3. Subdivision e of section 24-514 of the administrative code of the 27 city of New York is amended to read as follows:

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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e. Exemptions from sewer rents or charges. Any real property which is entitled to an exemption from the payment of water rents or charges shall also be exempt from payment of the sewer rents or charges imposed hereunder. IN ADDITION, ANY NOT-FOR-PROFIT ENTITY WHICH OWNS A BUILDING 5 OF ANY TYPE OR A DWELLING IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE AND WHICH INSTALLS A CHECK VALVE DEVICE TO PREVENT SEWAGE 7 BACK-FLOWING INTO SUCH BUILDING OR DWELLING SHALL RECEIVE AN ABATEMENT OF WATER AND SEWER CHARGES EQUALING ONE-HALF OF THE COST OF PURCHASING AND INSTALLING SUCH DEVICE, UP TO TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS. FOR THE 8 9 10 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE TERM "DWELLING" SHALL MEAN ANY BUILD-ING, STRUCTURE OR PORTION THEREOF WHICH IS OCCUPIED IN WHOLE OR IN PART 11 AS A HOME, RESIDENCE OR SLEEPING PLACE FOR ONE OR MORE HUMAN BEINGS. 12 13

S 4. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law.
